TIMELINE EVENT FILTERS

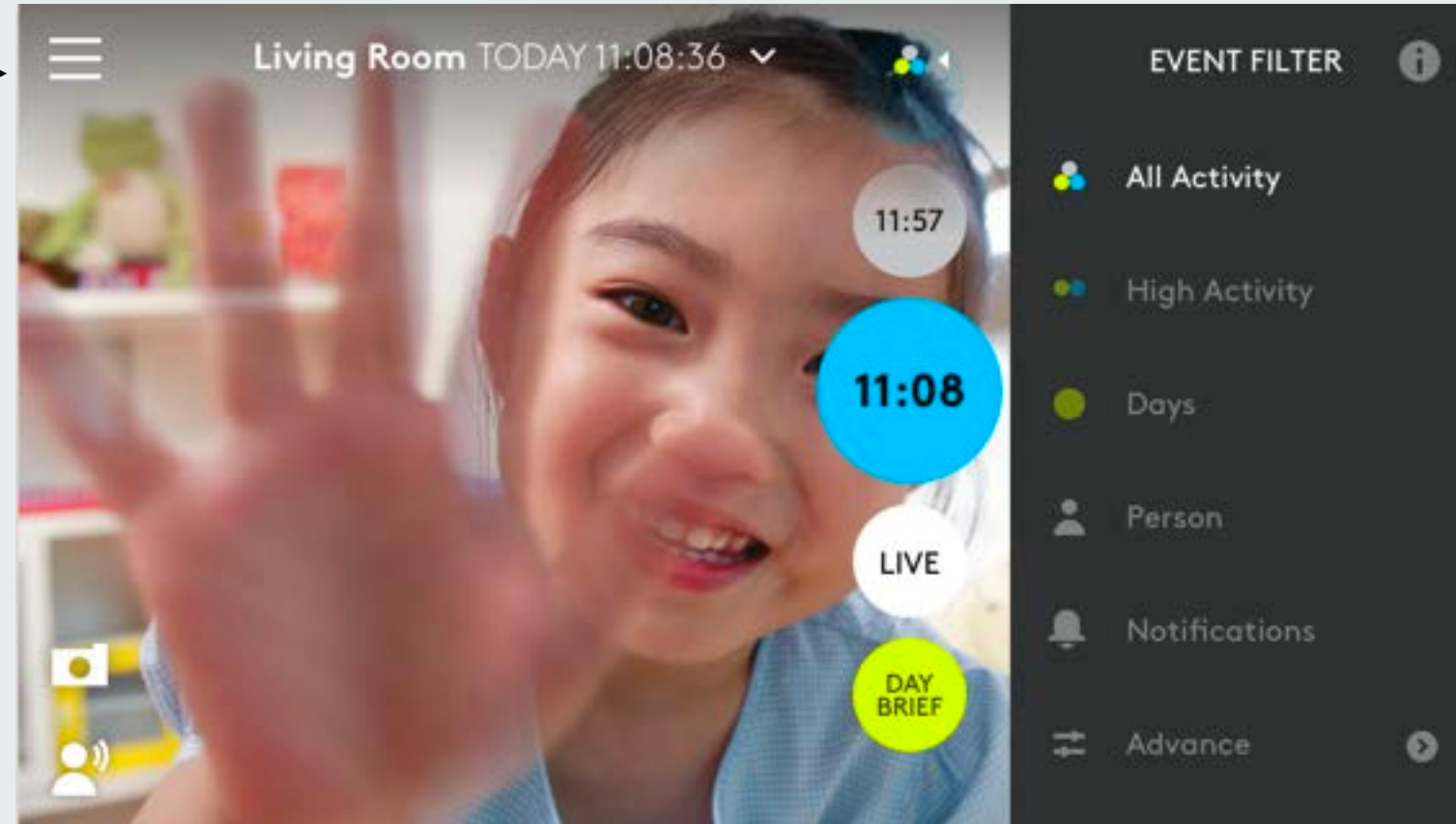
Event filters enable user to define what parameters they want associated with events they see in timeline- activity level, subjects, zones and/or many others. Available on all touch points

1. Edit filter settings

1. Access the control to edit filters for viewing events from this screen



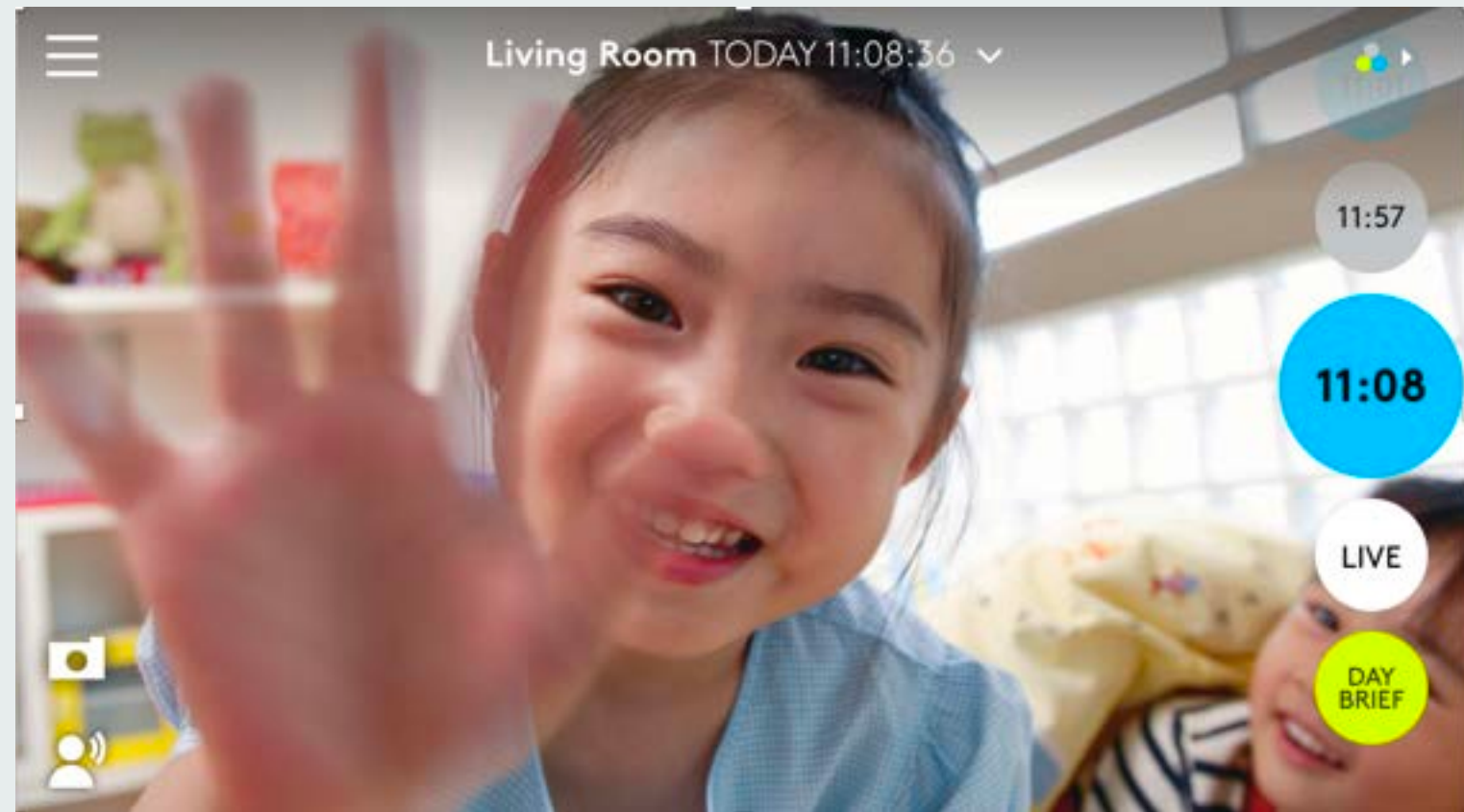
2. Tap on the icon or swipe from right to left to access filters



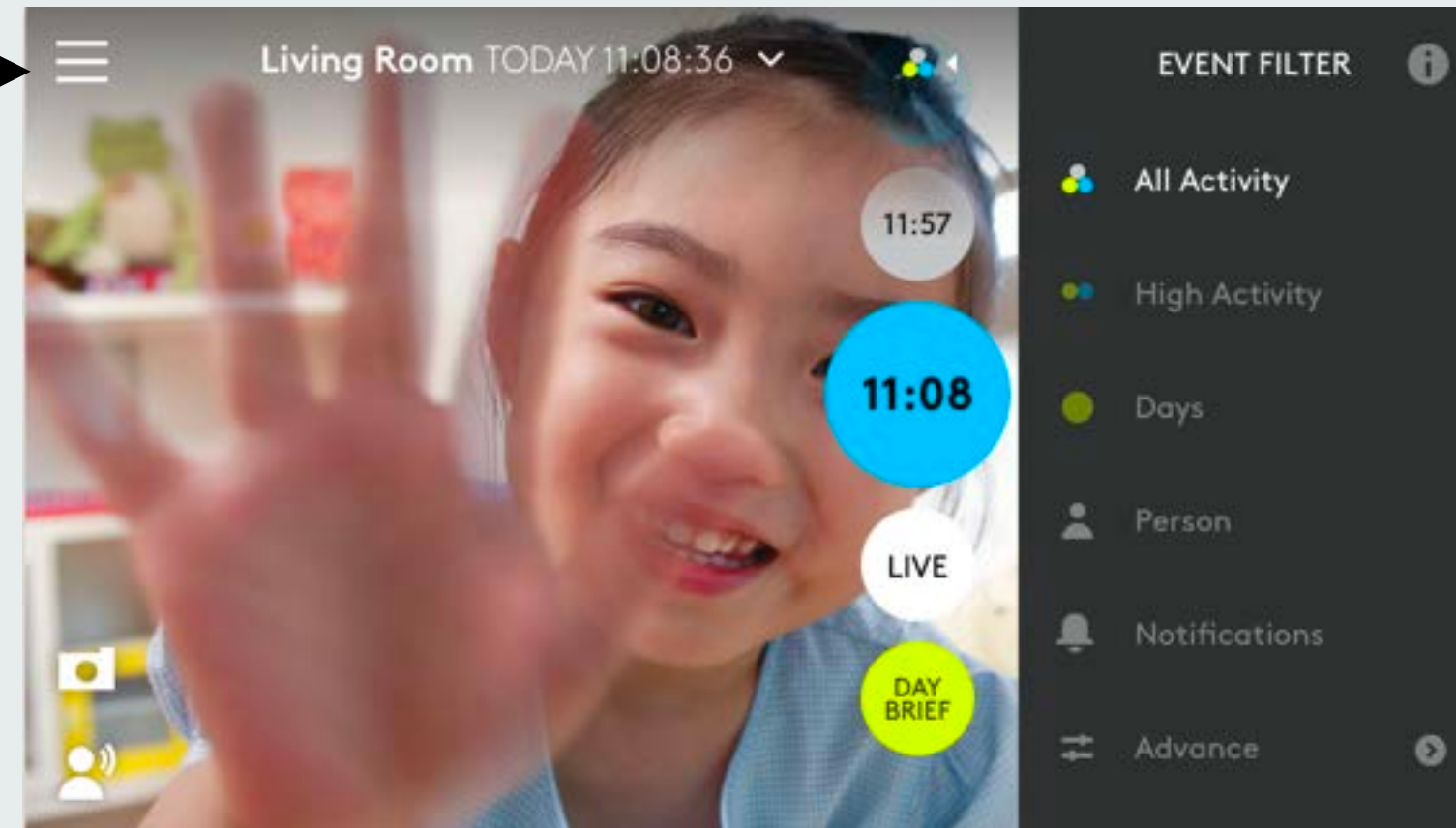
..... You can select any one type of filter at a time

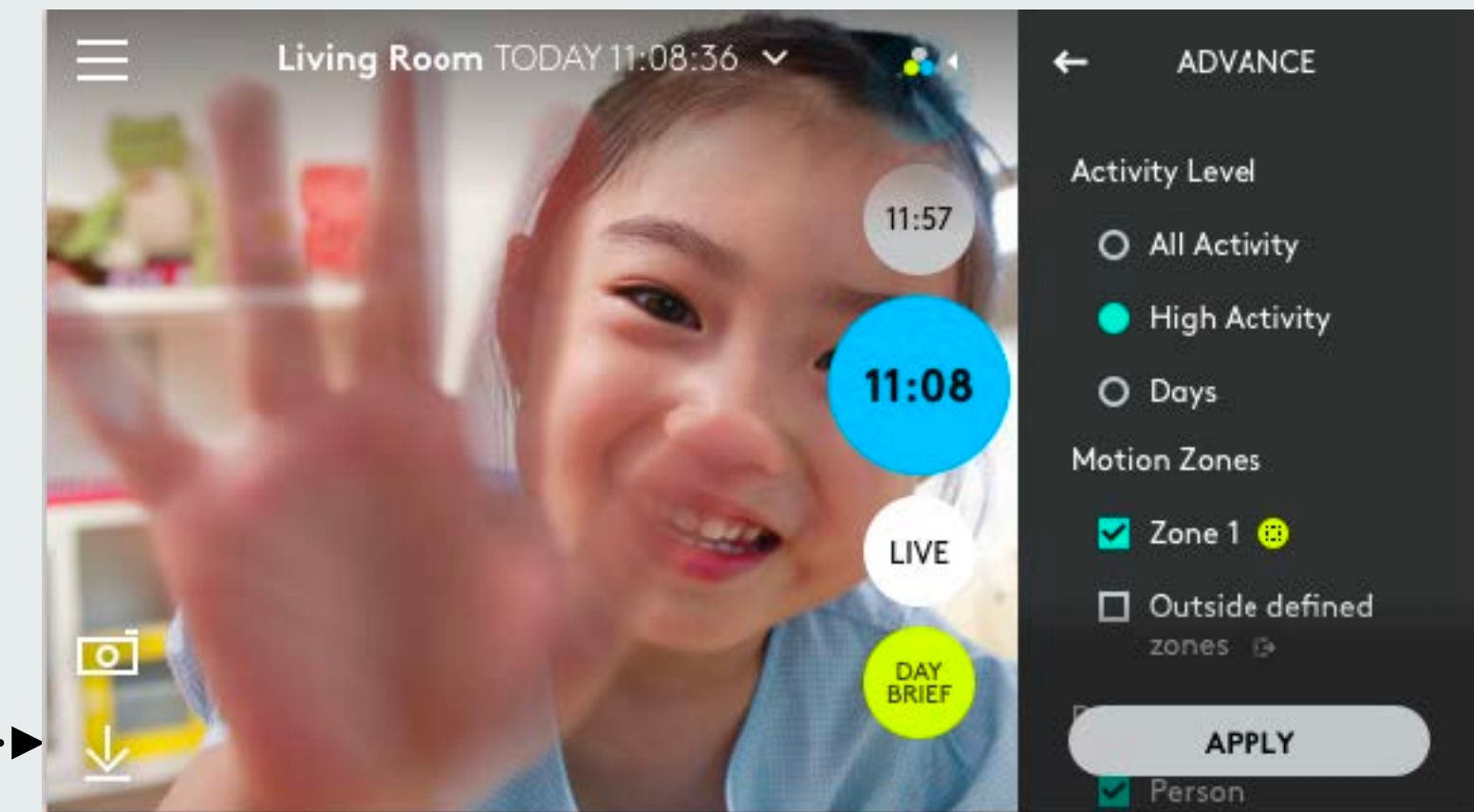

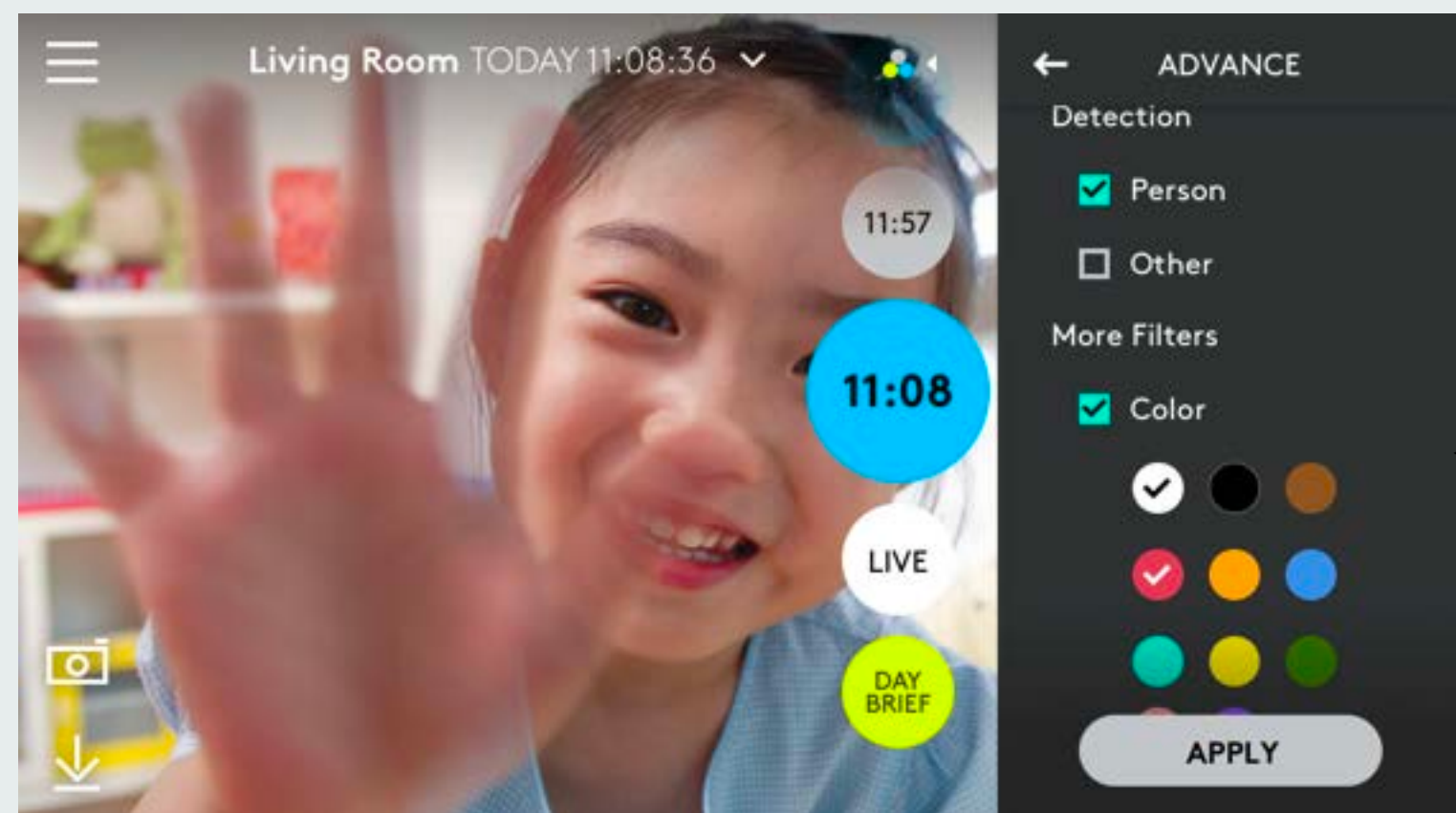

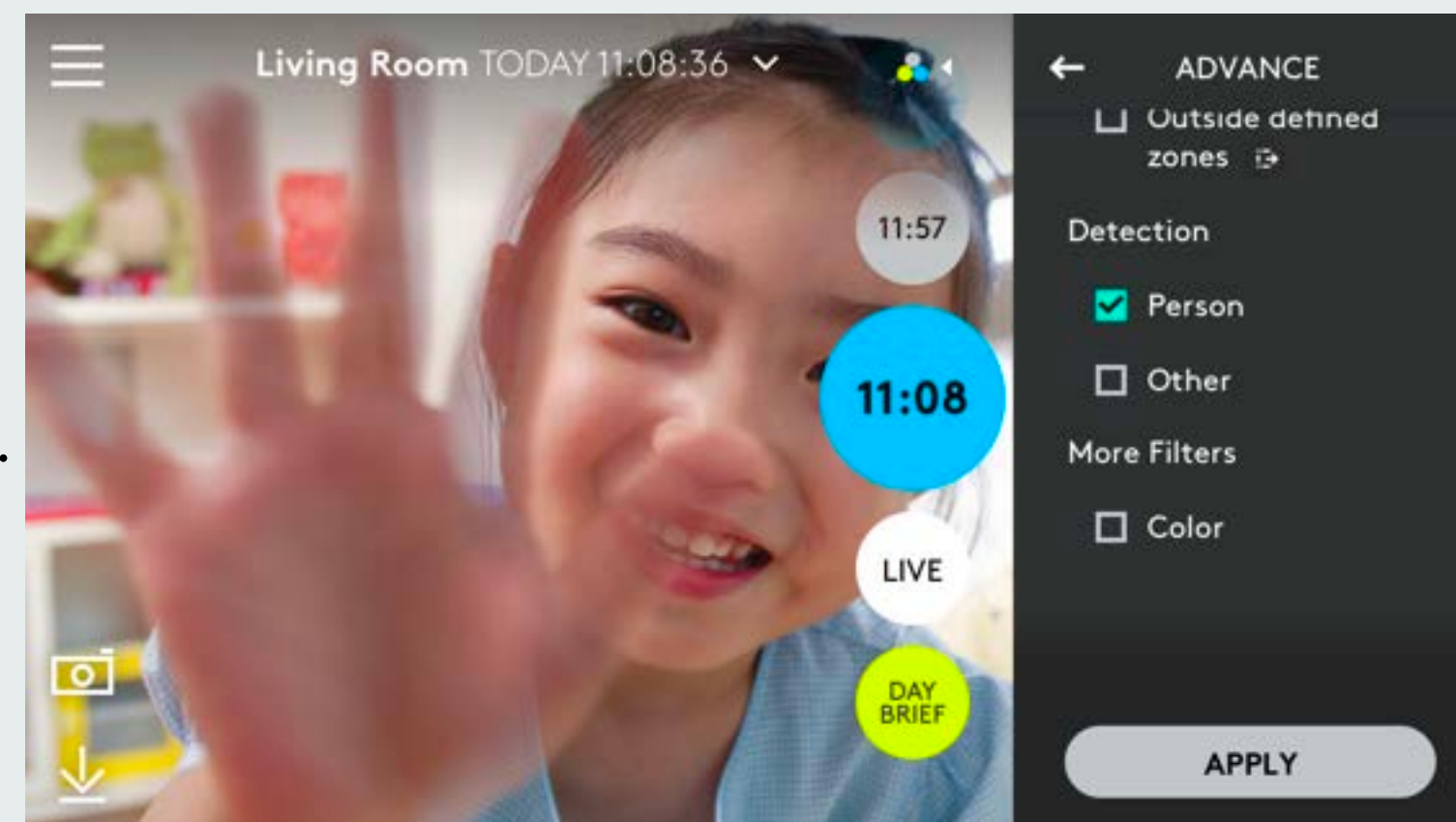
3. With advanced filters, you can use a combination of settings to filter events in timeline

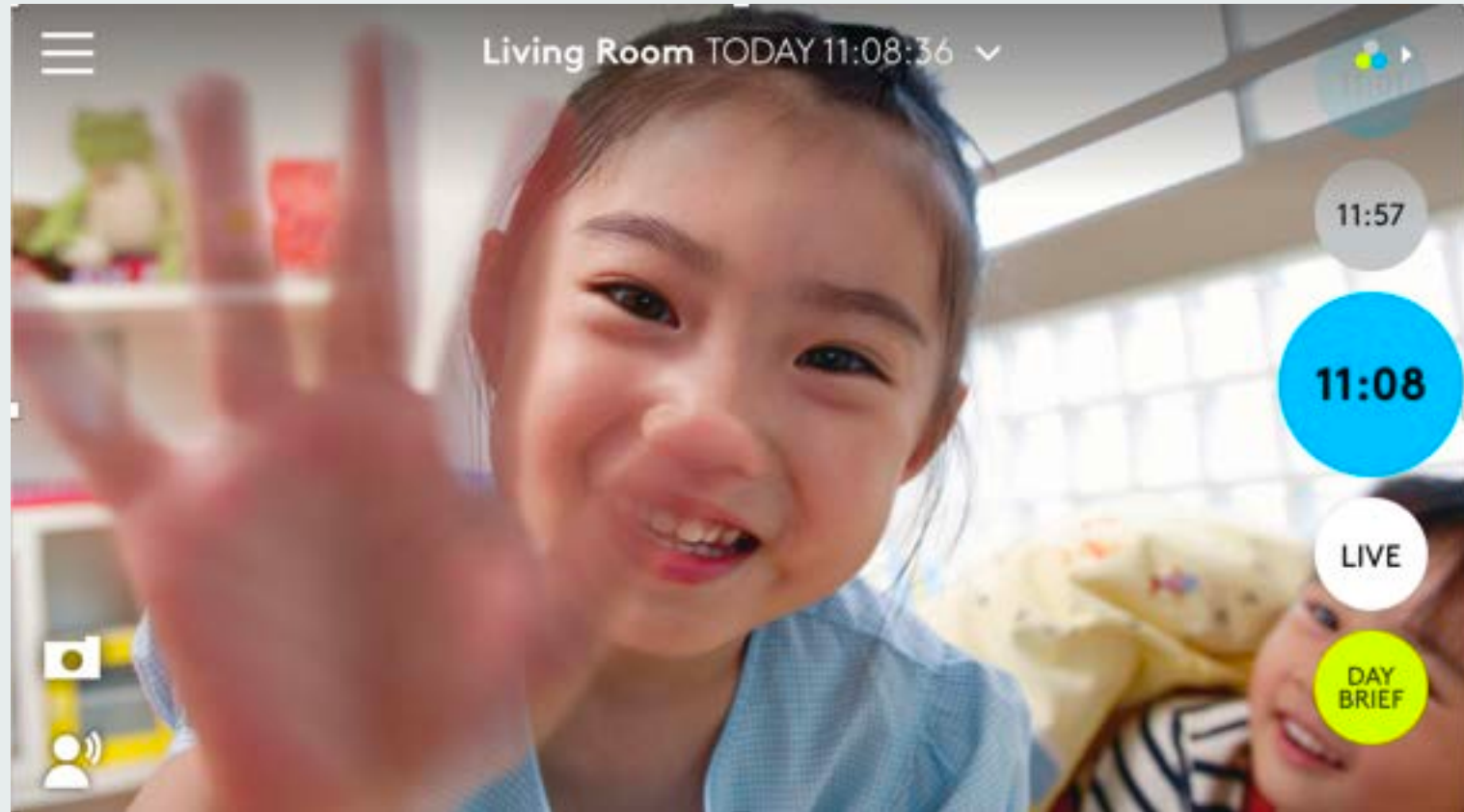

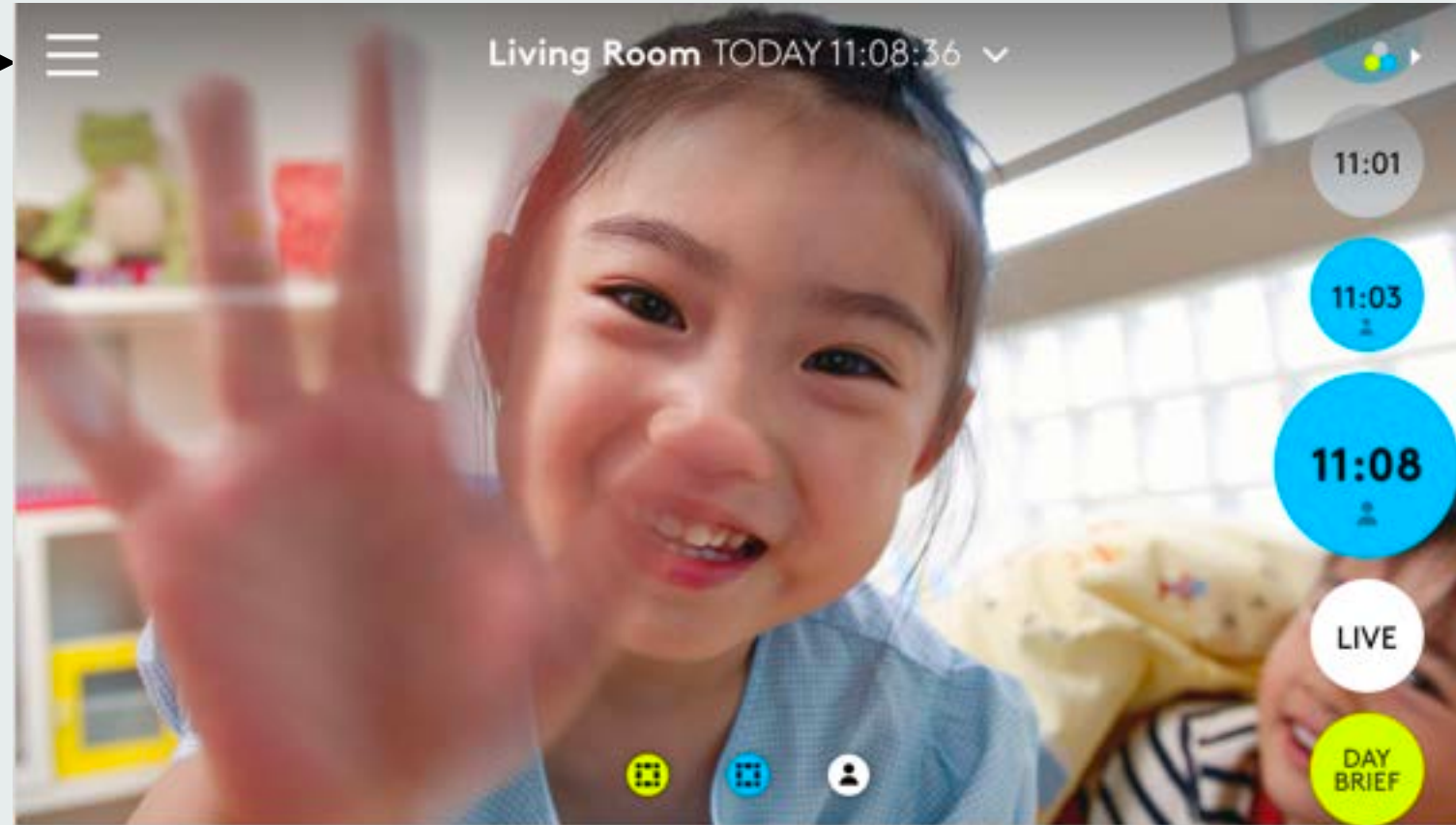
You can tap 'apply' and the column will close. You will see camera detail screen with events in timeline as per the filters

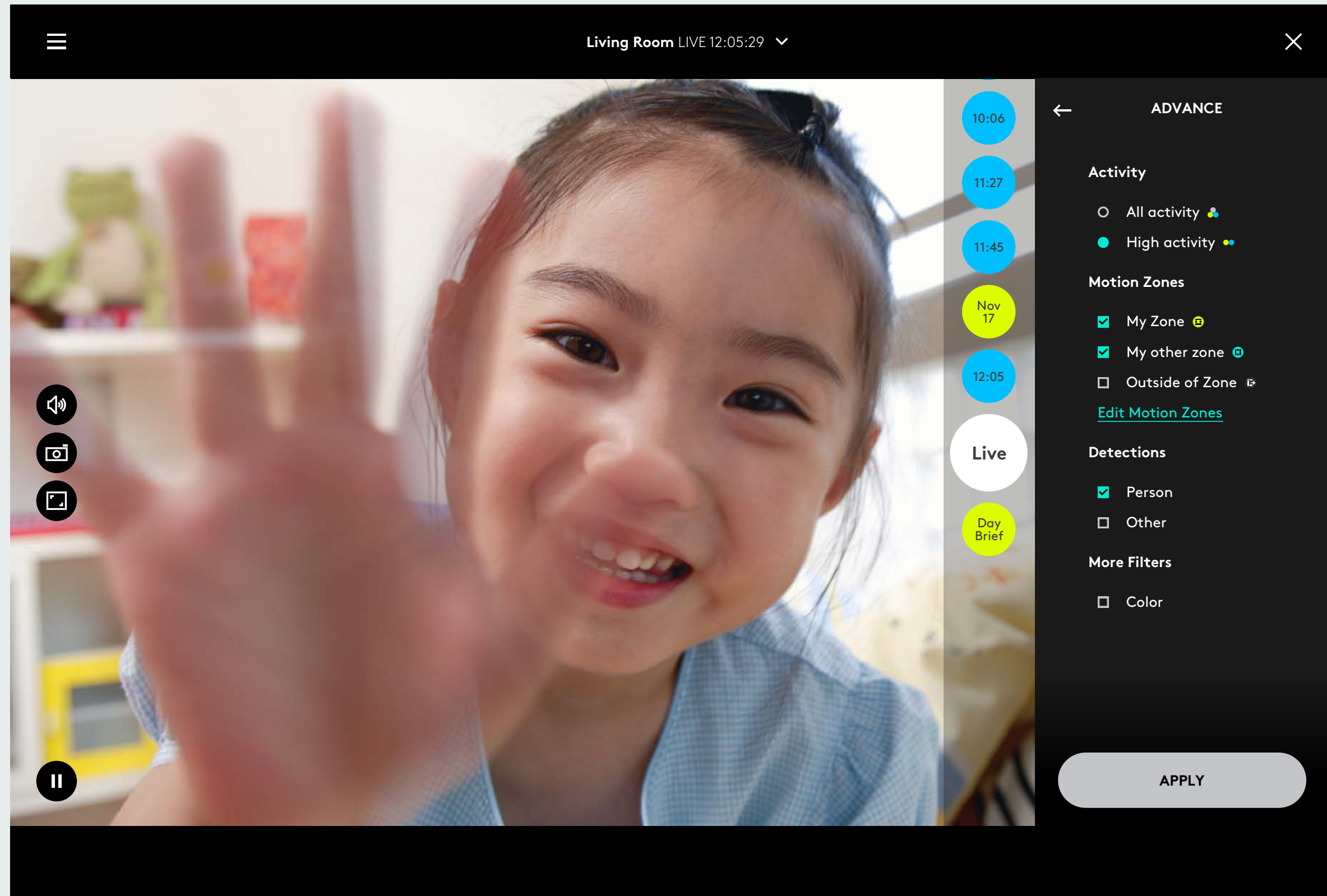


TIMELINE EVENT FILTERS | WEB APP EXCEPTION

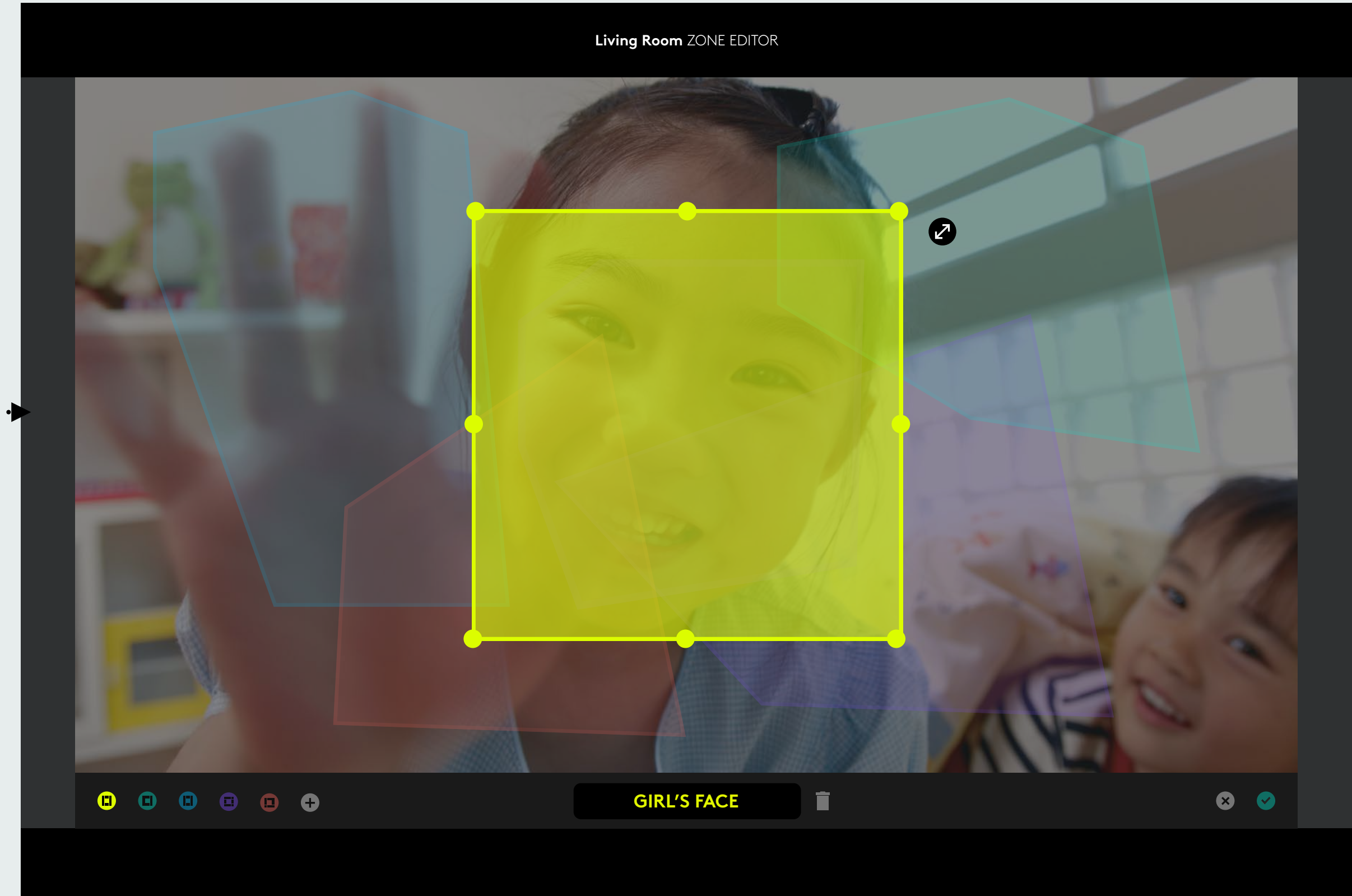
The web app has an additional control in event filters of accessing an edit of zones that they might want to use for filtering the timeline

1. Ability to edit motion zones from Advanced filters

1. There is an option to edit zones if needed while selecting a zone as an event filter on web app only



2. Tapping on the option, takes you to the zone editor



SMART ALERTS

Smart alerts notify you of the moments that matter on your mobile, no matter where you are. You can customize alert or frequency or sensitivity. If you add Circle Premium, alerts can also tell when a person was detected and (once motion zones are defined) exactly where in home the action took place. Available on mobile and tablet app only

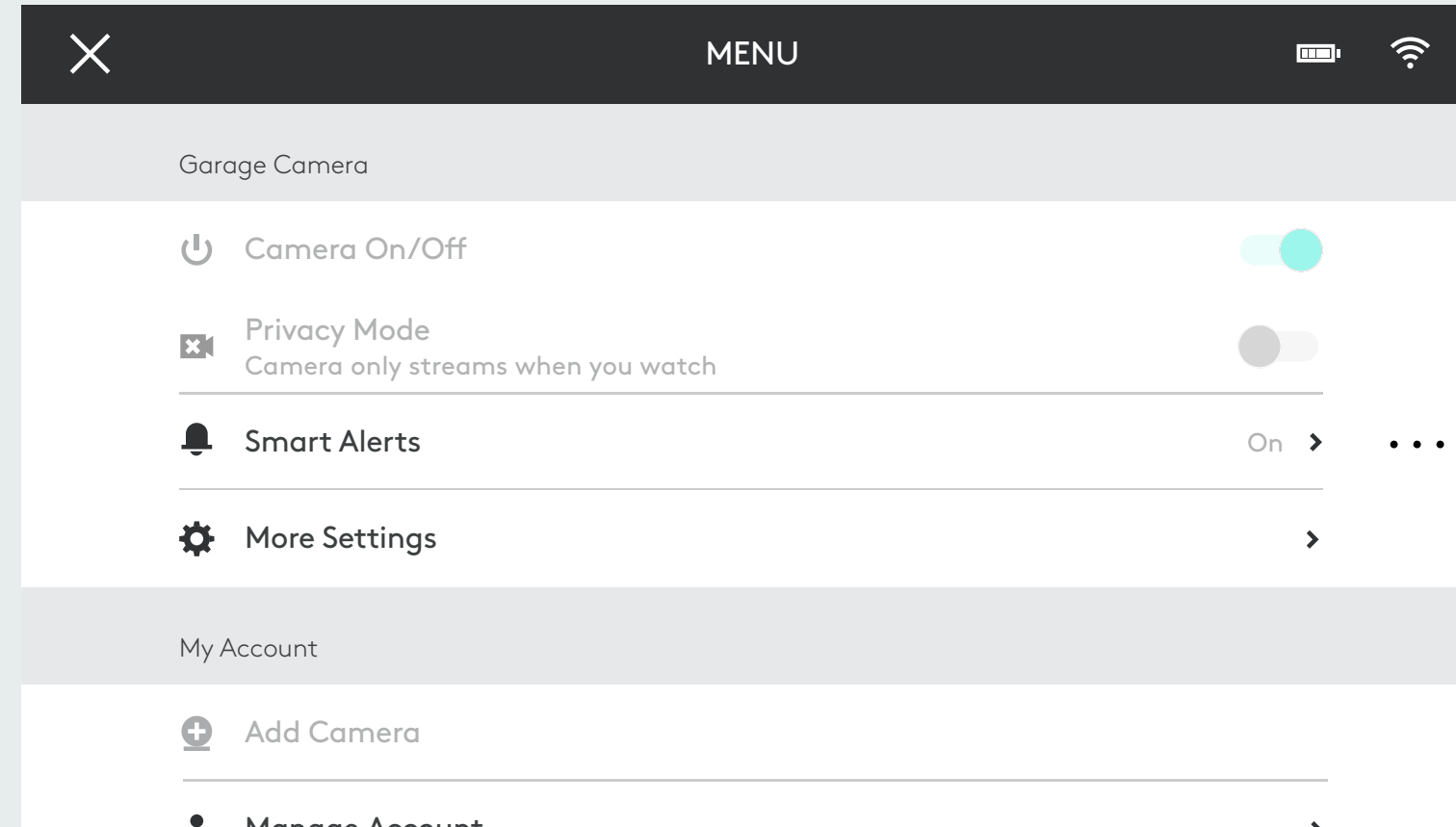

ZONE EDITOR

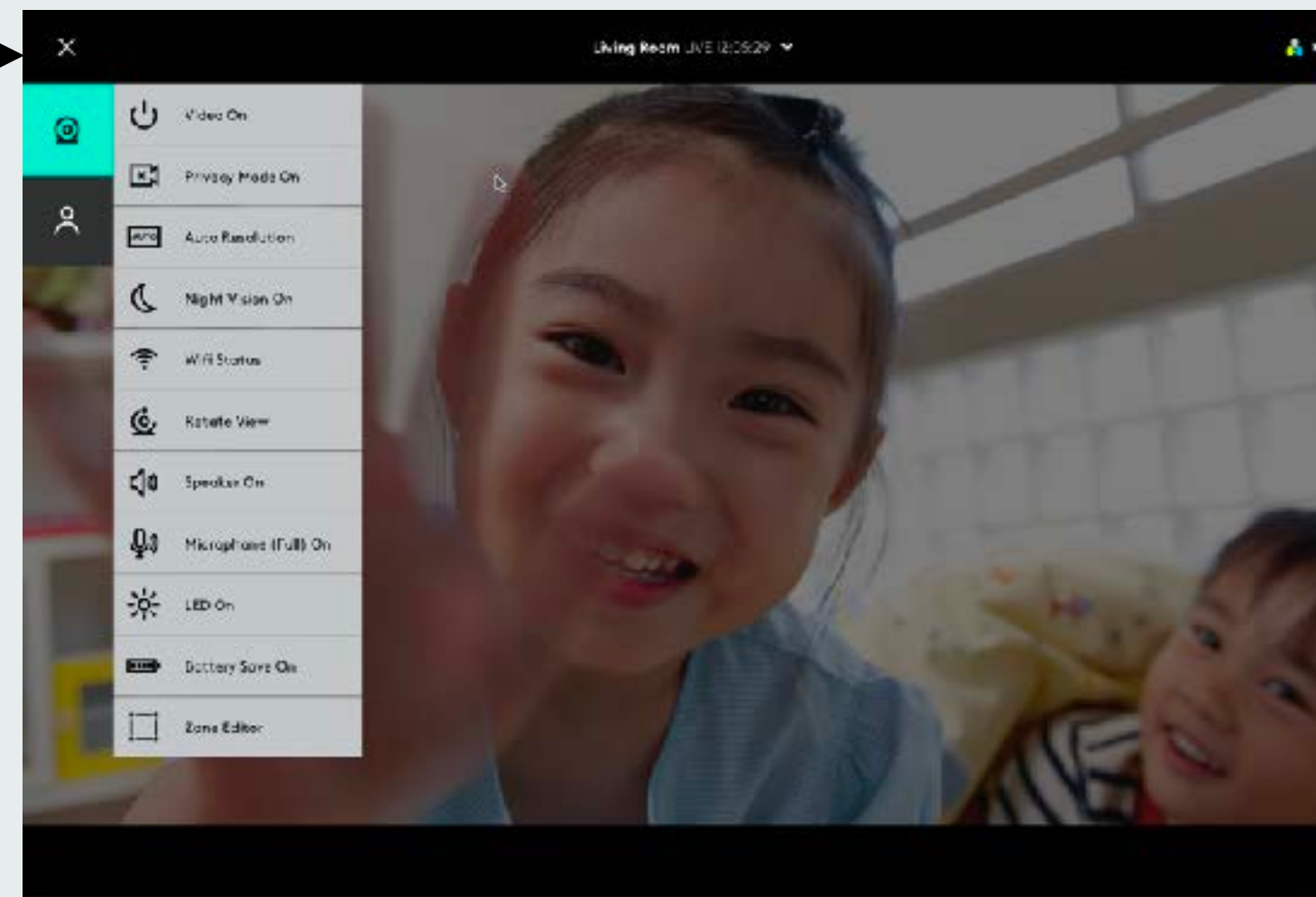
Motion Zones notify you if Circle 2 senses motion in specific areas of the house, like the front door, garage door or windows. Circle Safe Premium subscribers can create up to 5 custom Motion Zones through the Circle web app. Future releases will have it on mobile and tablet as well.

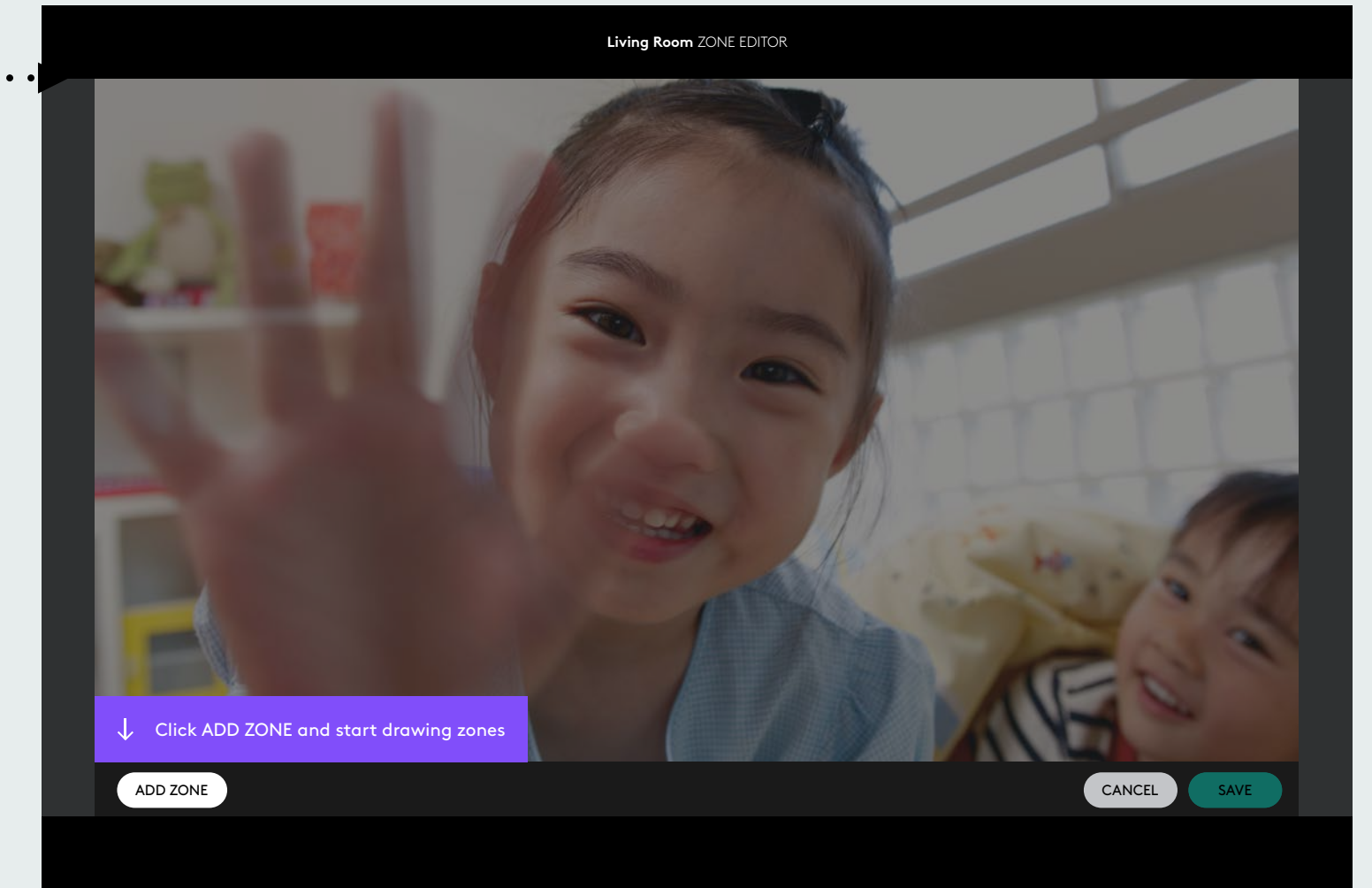
1. Web app camera detail screen to go to menu



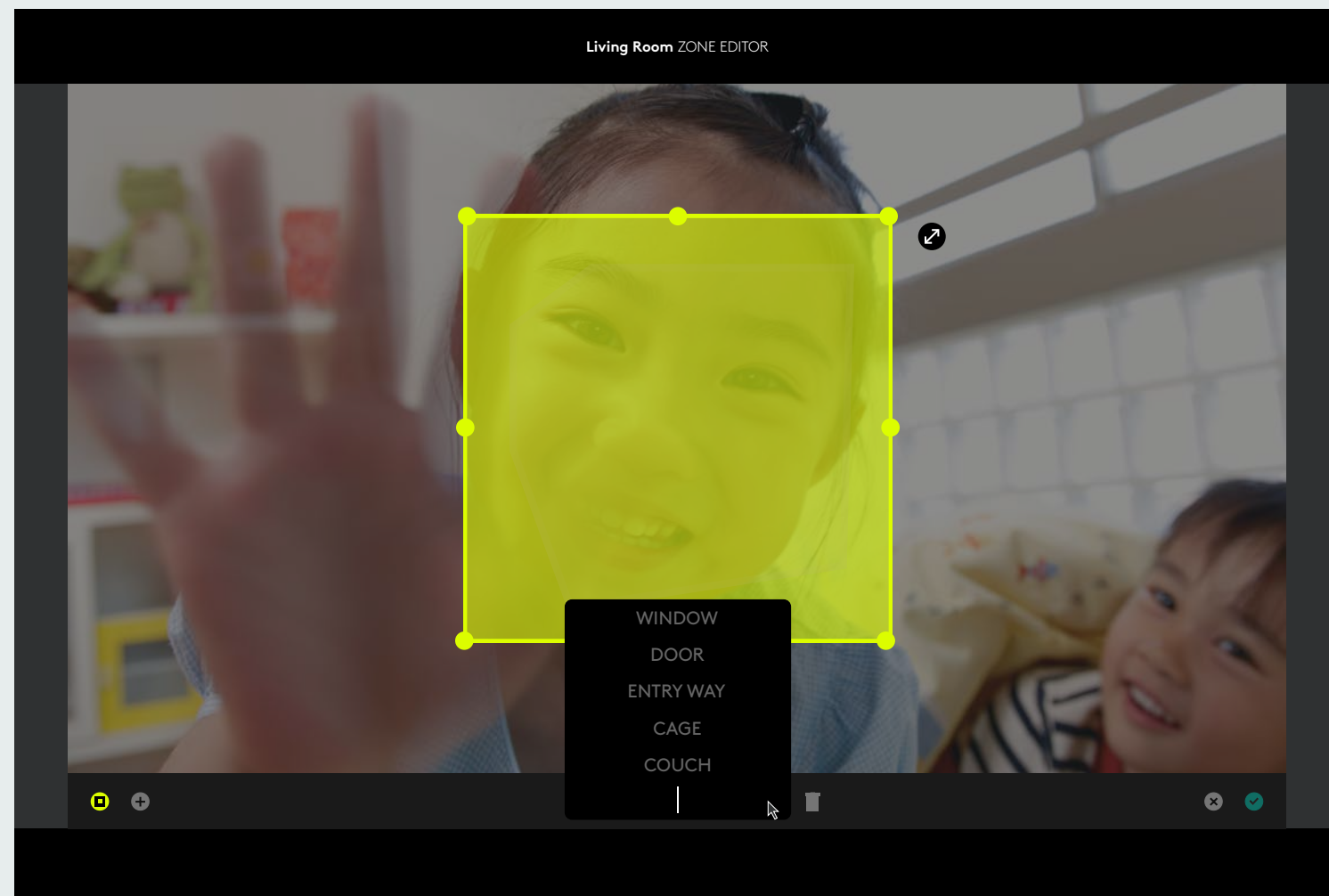
2. Access zone editor from menu



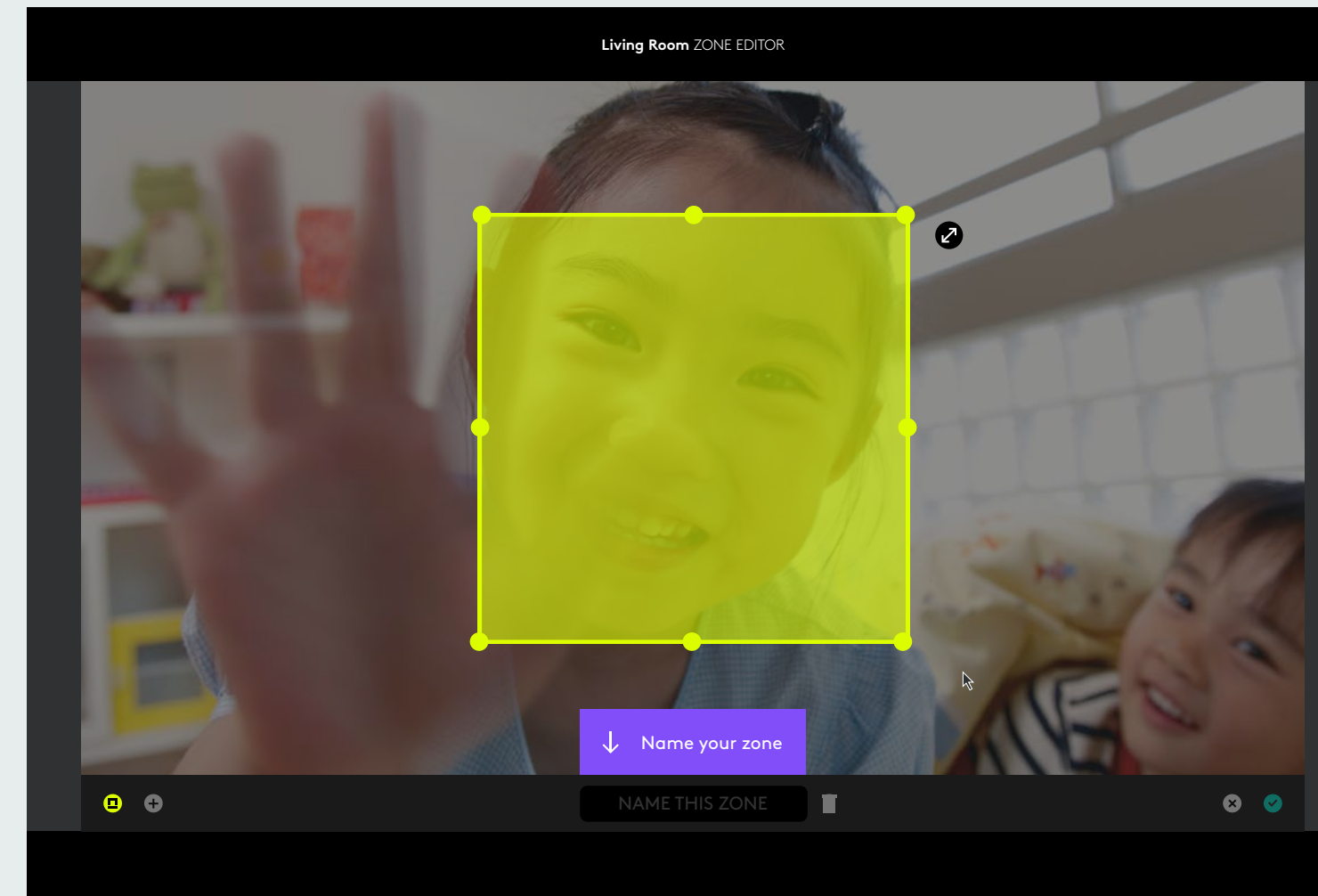
3. Choose to add a zone. You will be shown prompts if you are creating zones for the first time



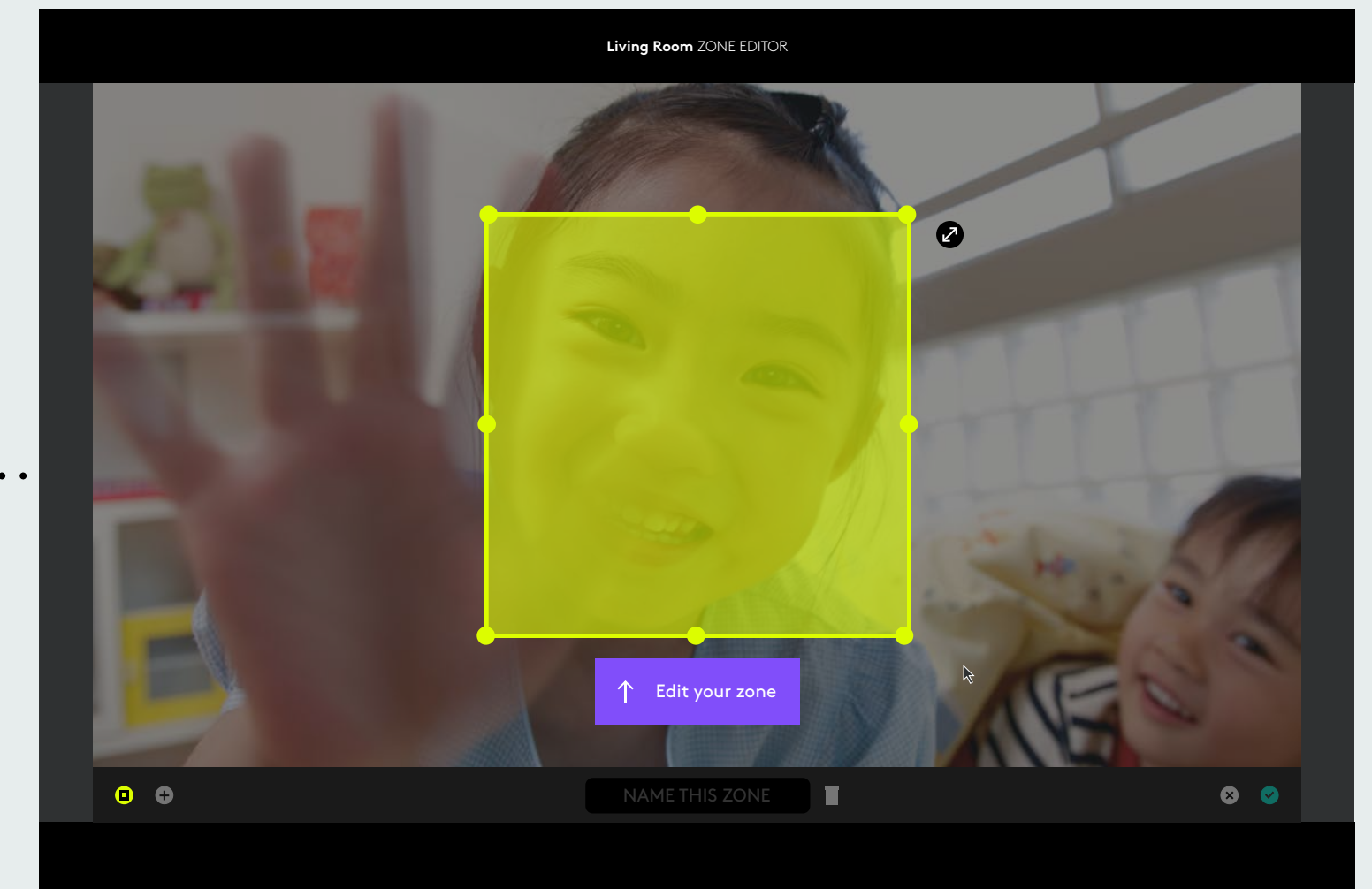
6. Choose from names in the list or give a custom name



5. Once you have edited it, you can give the zone a name

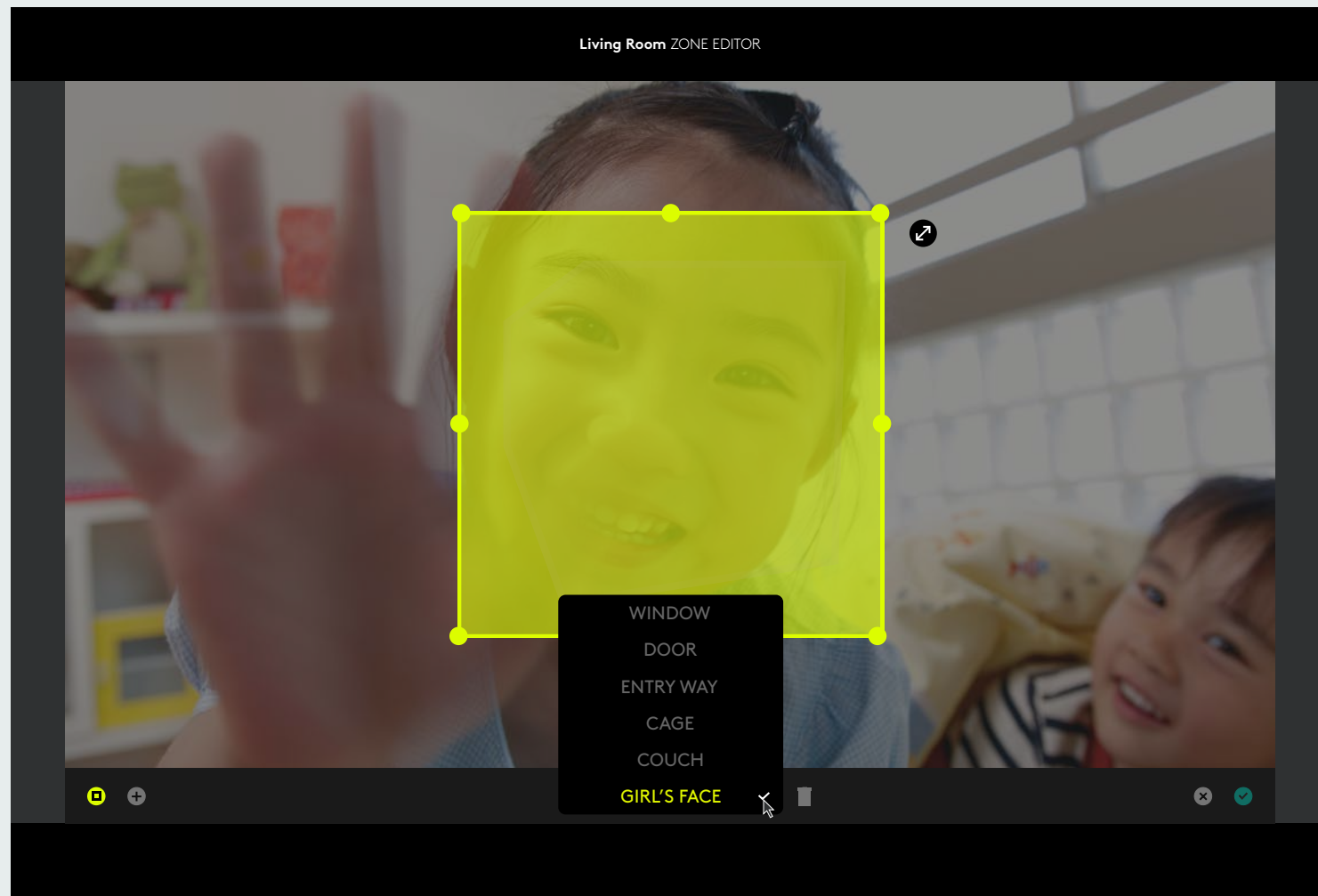


4. Tapping on 'Add zone' generates a square vector. You can edit it

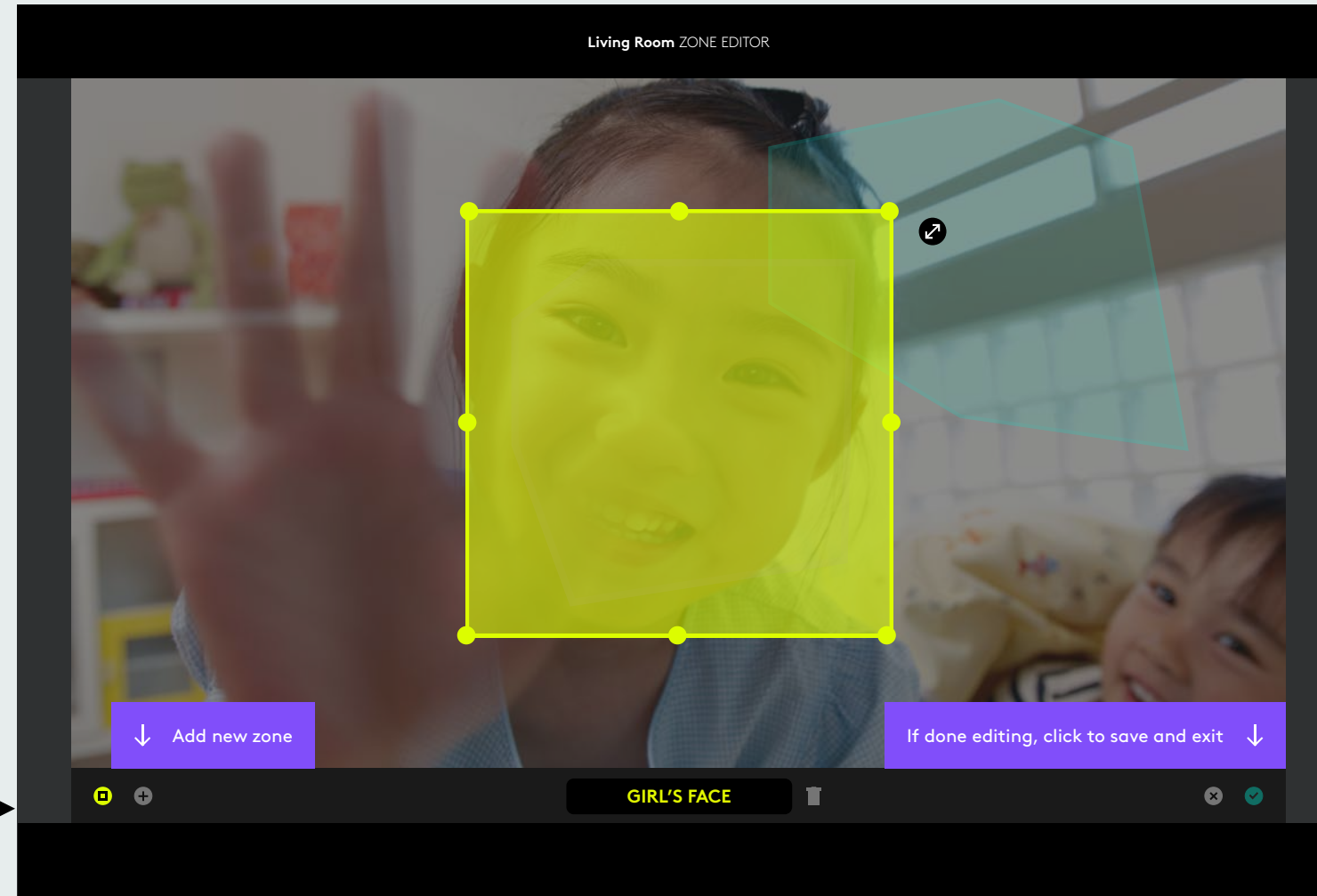

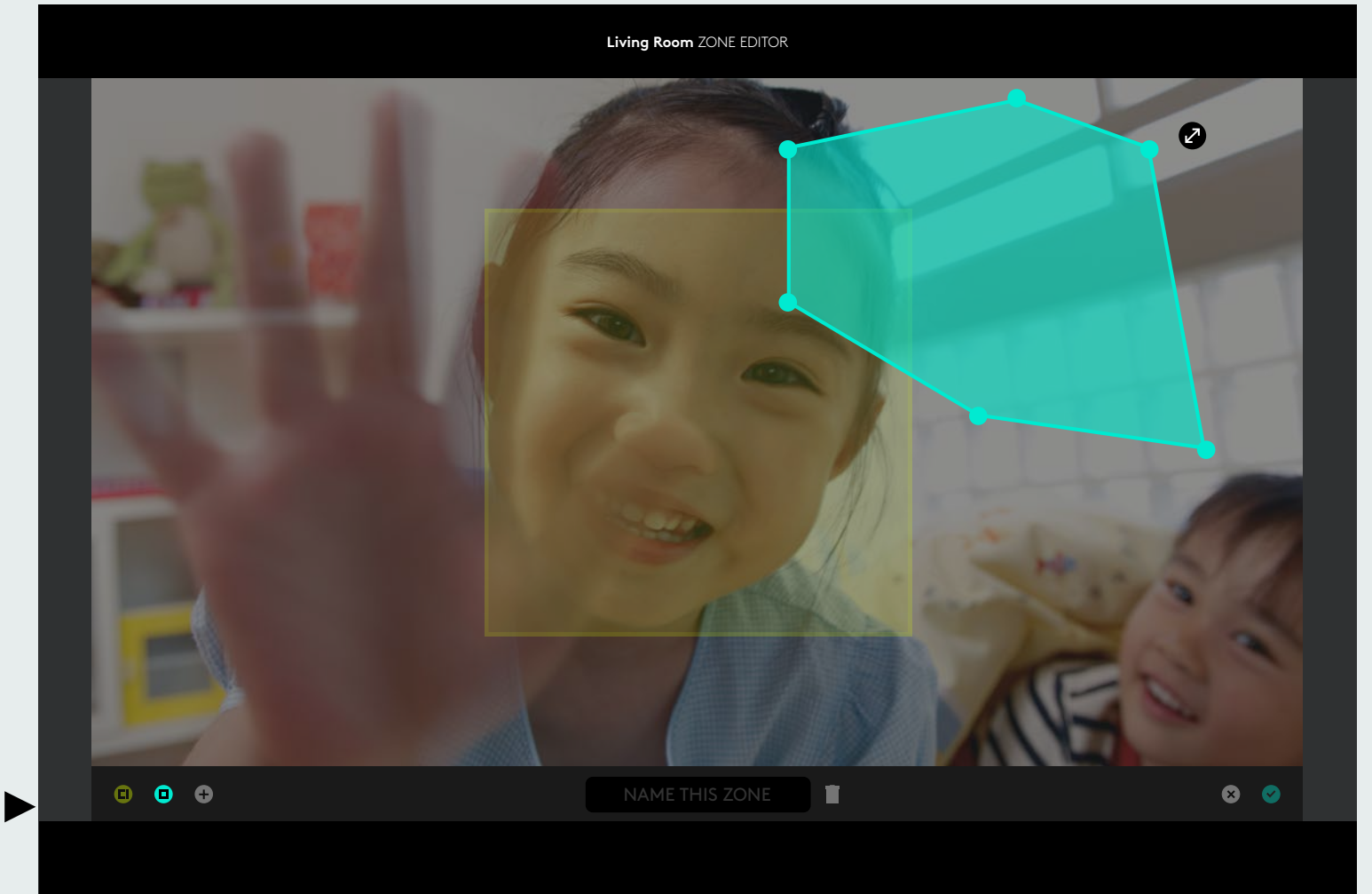
7. If you have given a custom name, it gets assigned and is saved



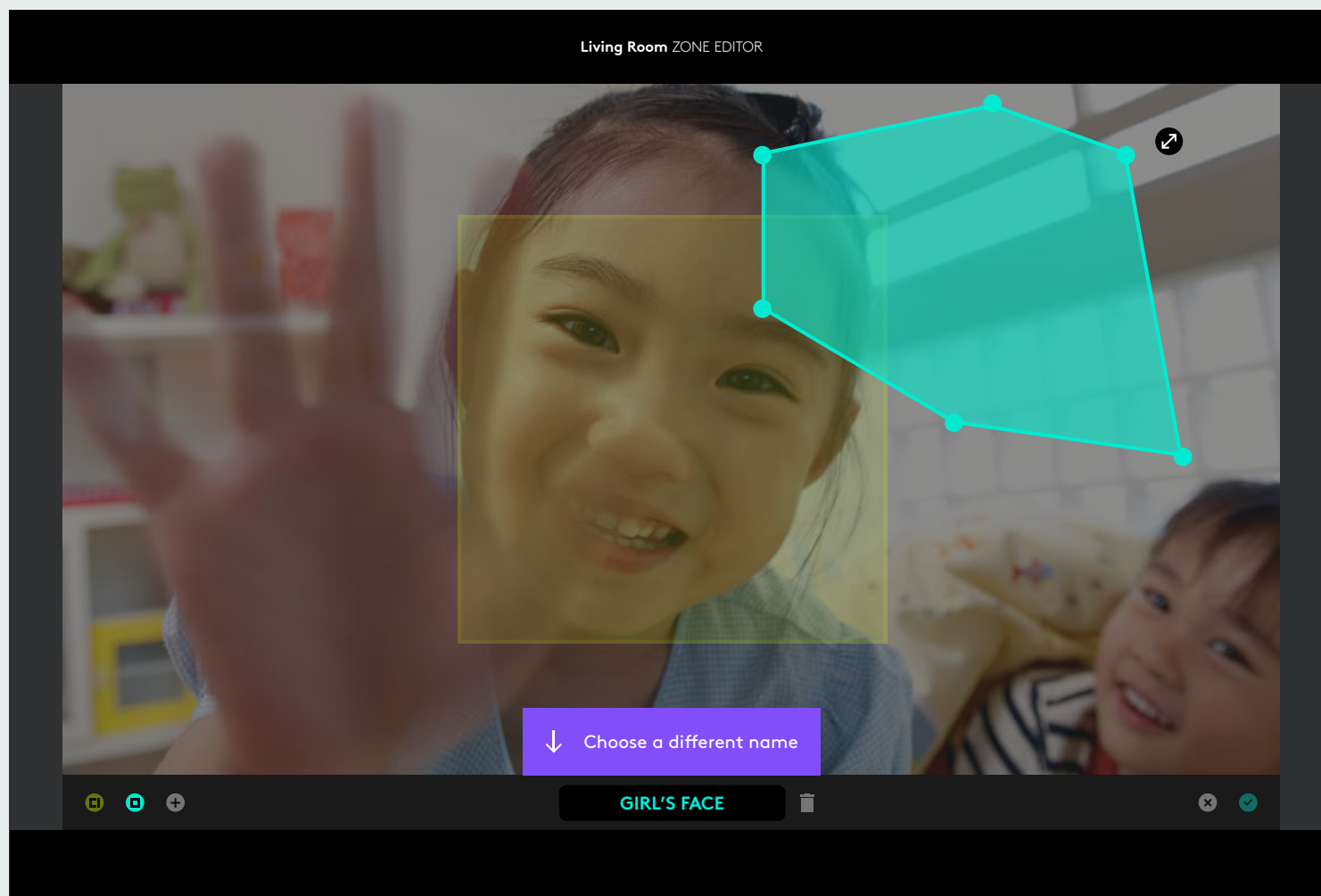
8. Next you can choose to add another zone



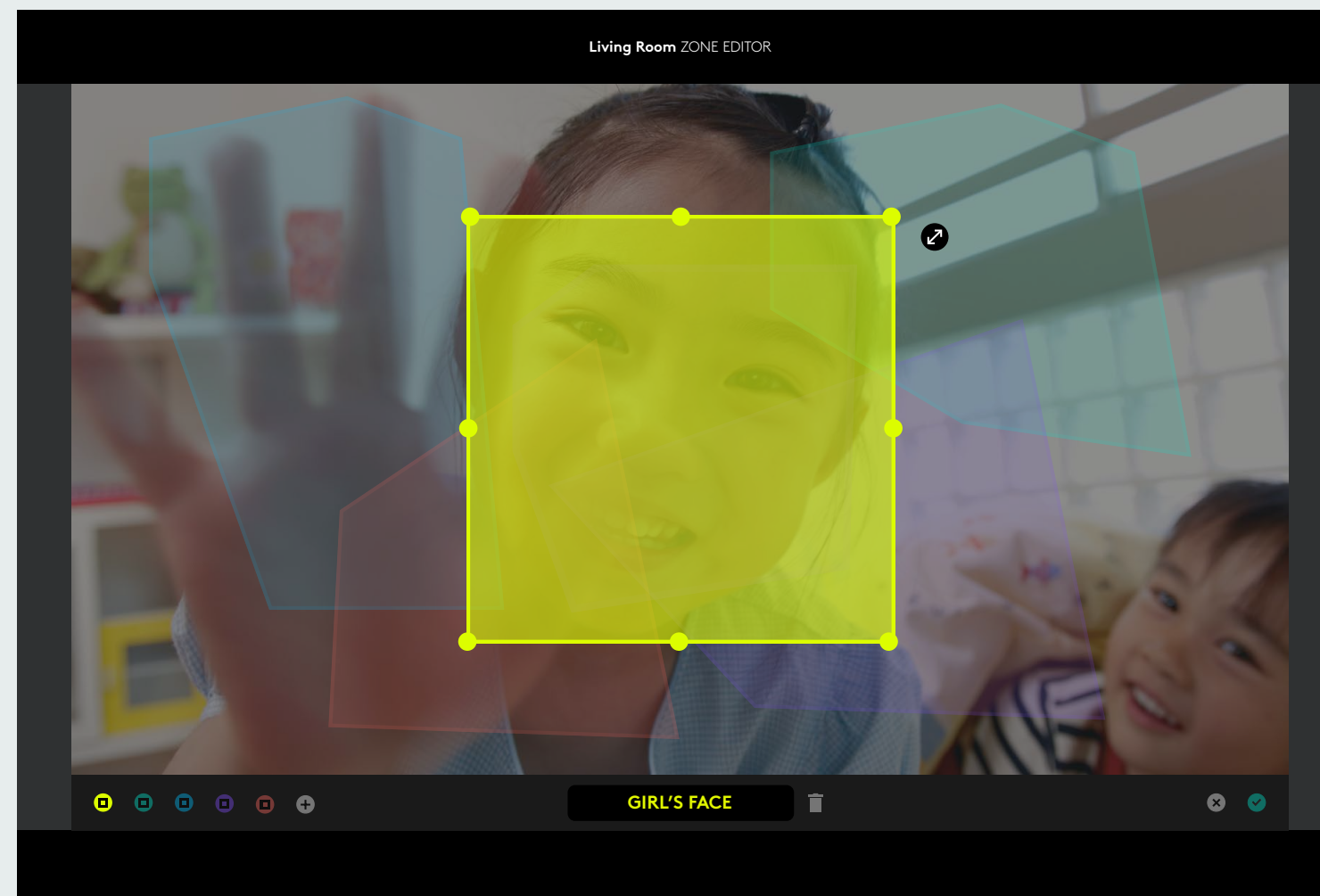
9. The zone can be edited using an anchor point or as a whole shape. It can overlap another zone as well to a point



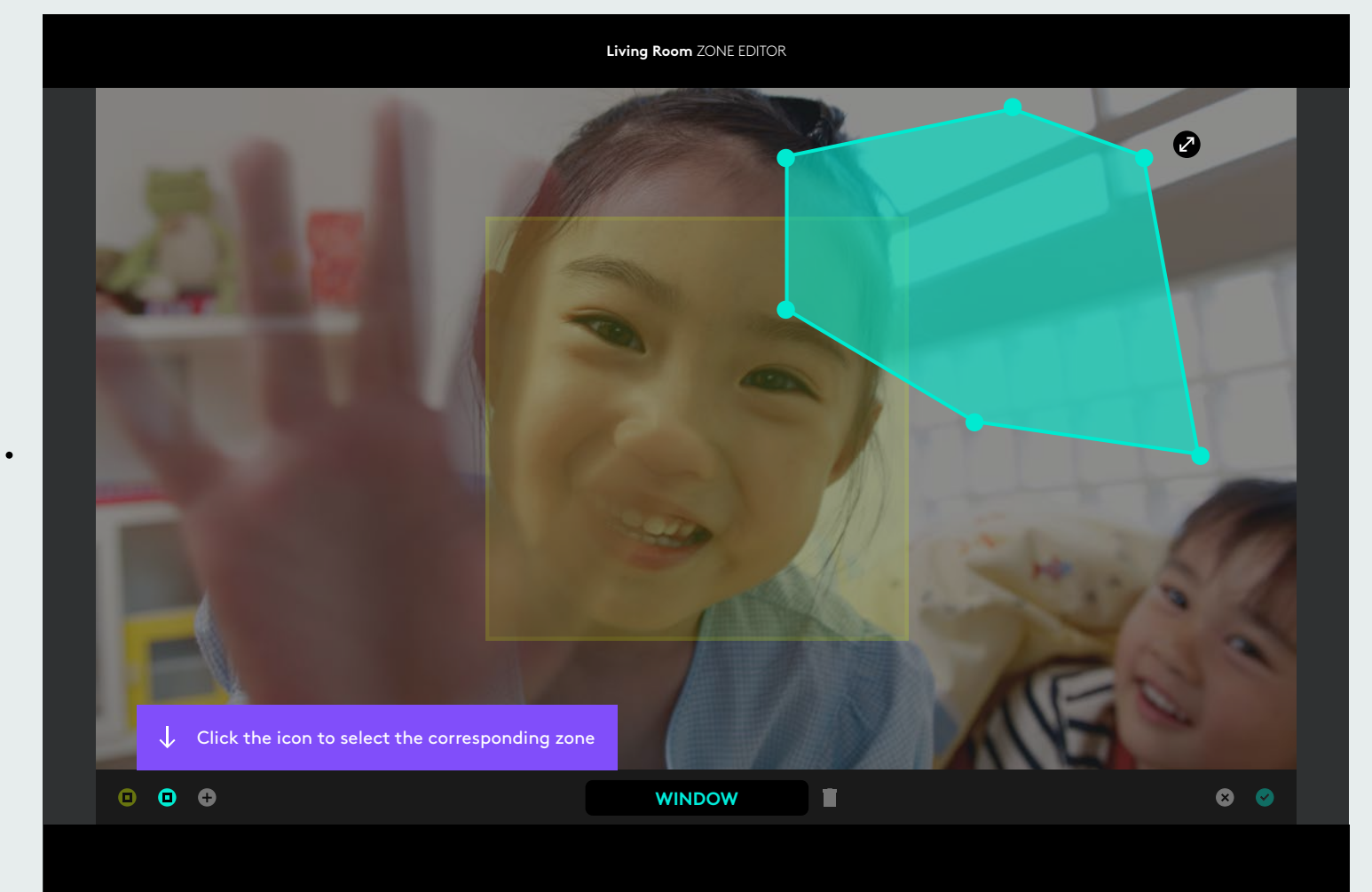
12. If a zone name is taken, you will be prompted to give another name



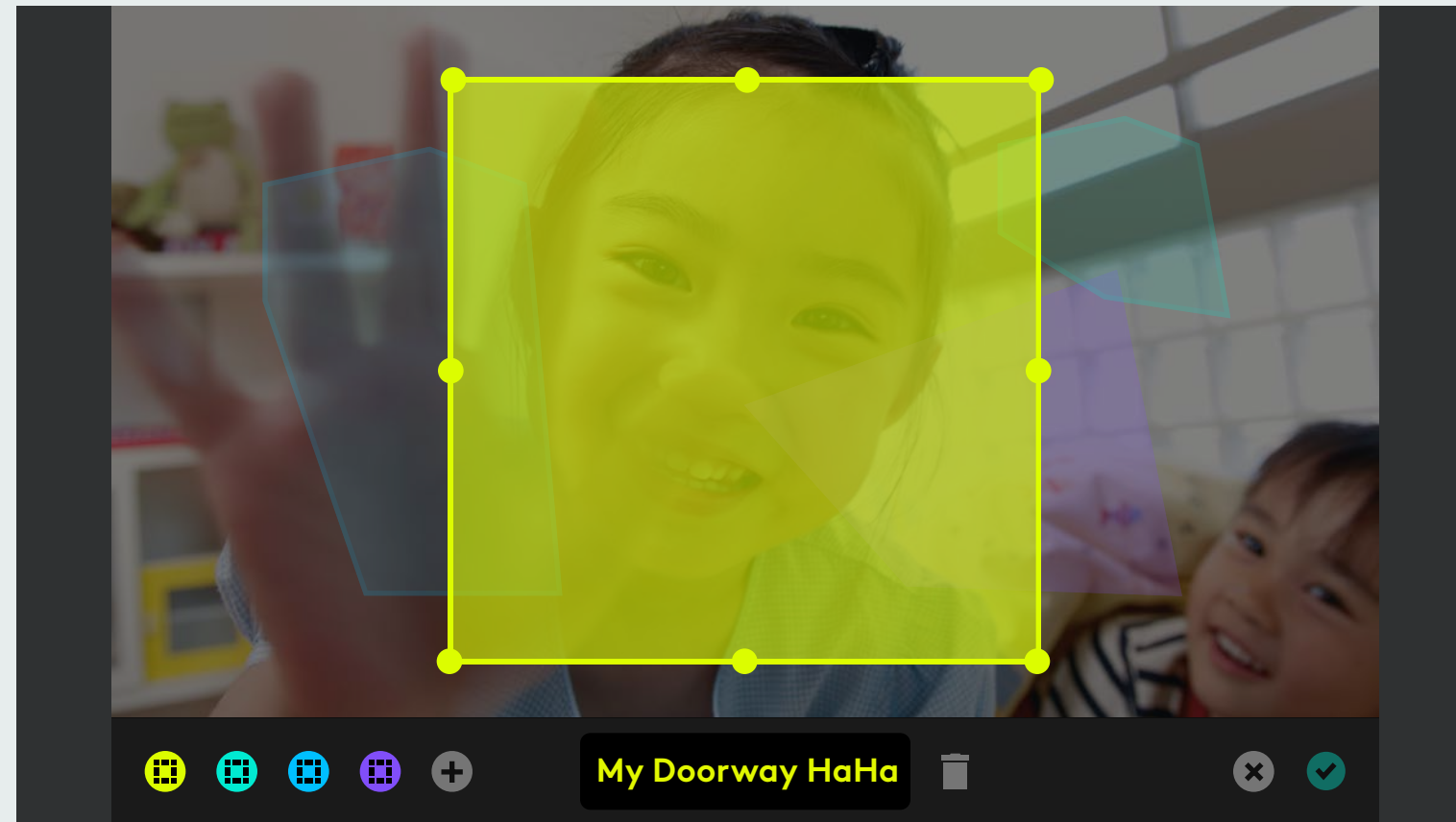
11. You can create up to 5 zones for a camera

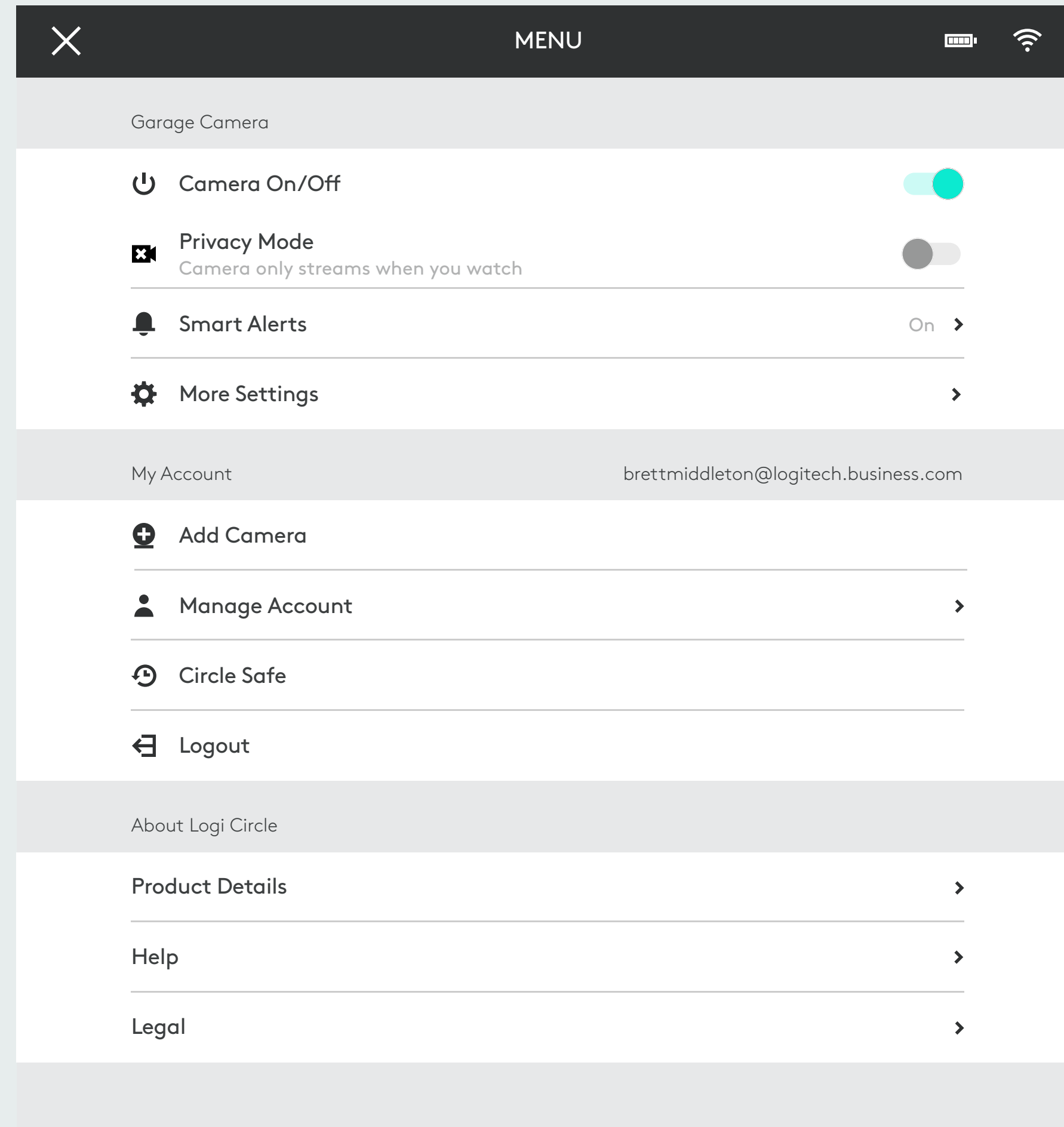
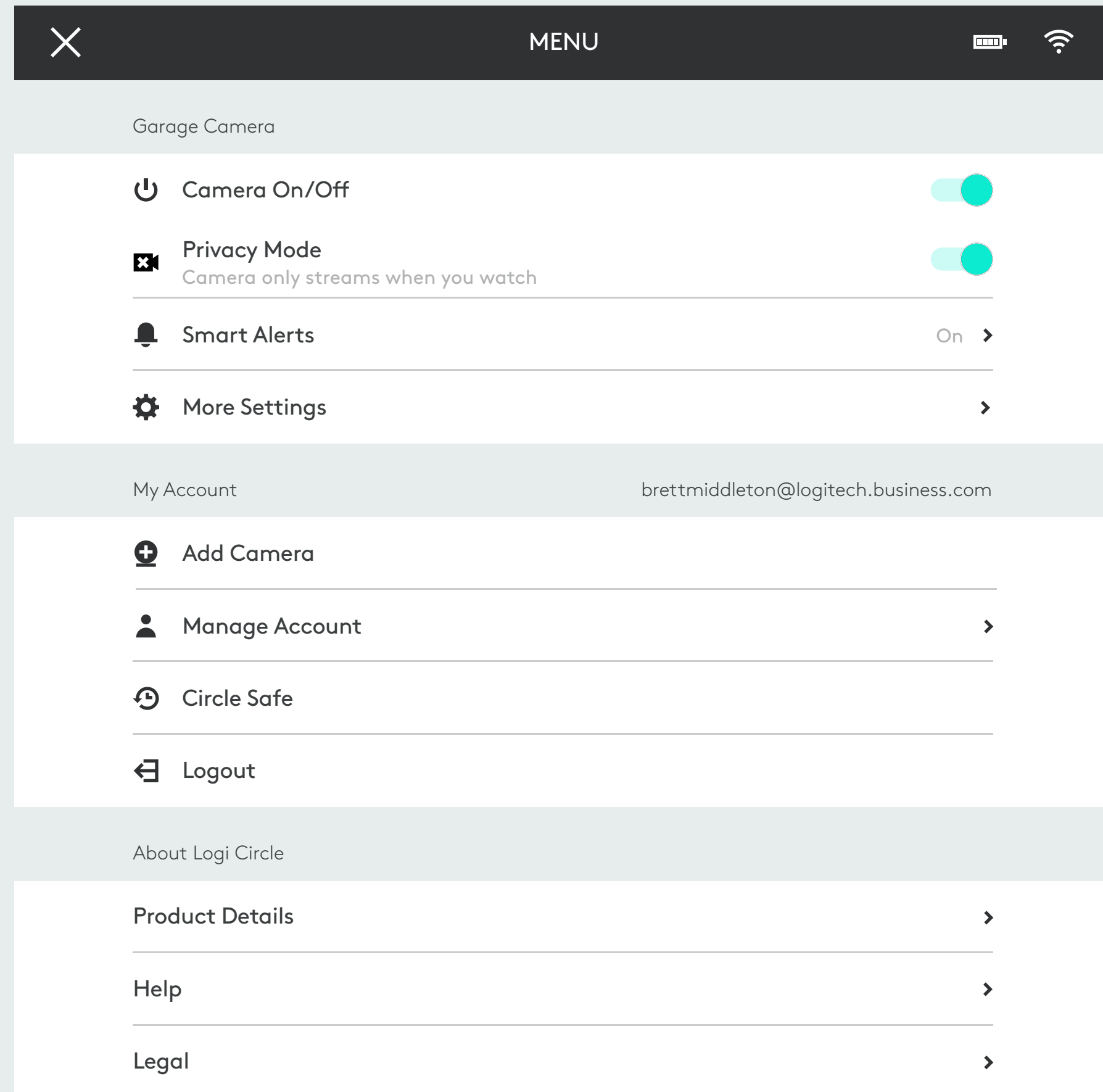

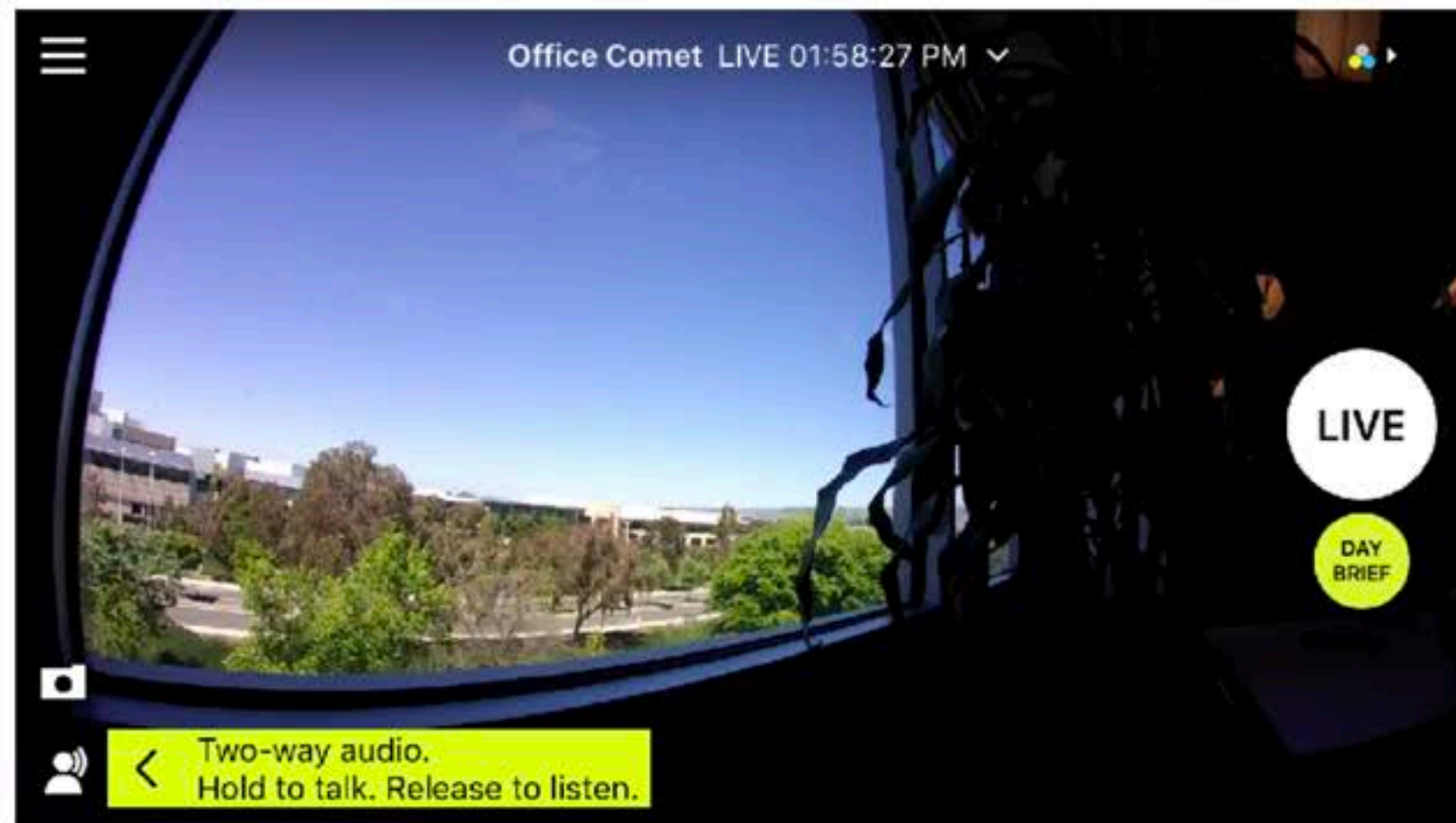

TOOL TIPS SYSTEM

Contextual tooltips appear for first time users and when new features are released. A few examples here. Available on all touch points

Example of tooltip

Push to talk —



When to show this tip?

1. If we find users not trying out push to talk during the second launch.
2. Dismiss the tip when user taps anywhere except the icon itself.
3. Show this tip if user taps on the icon instead of long press. (until user learns to do it)

" Hold to talk and release to listen"

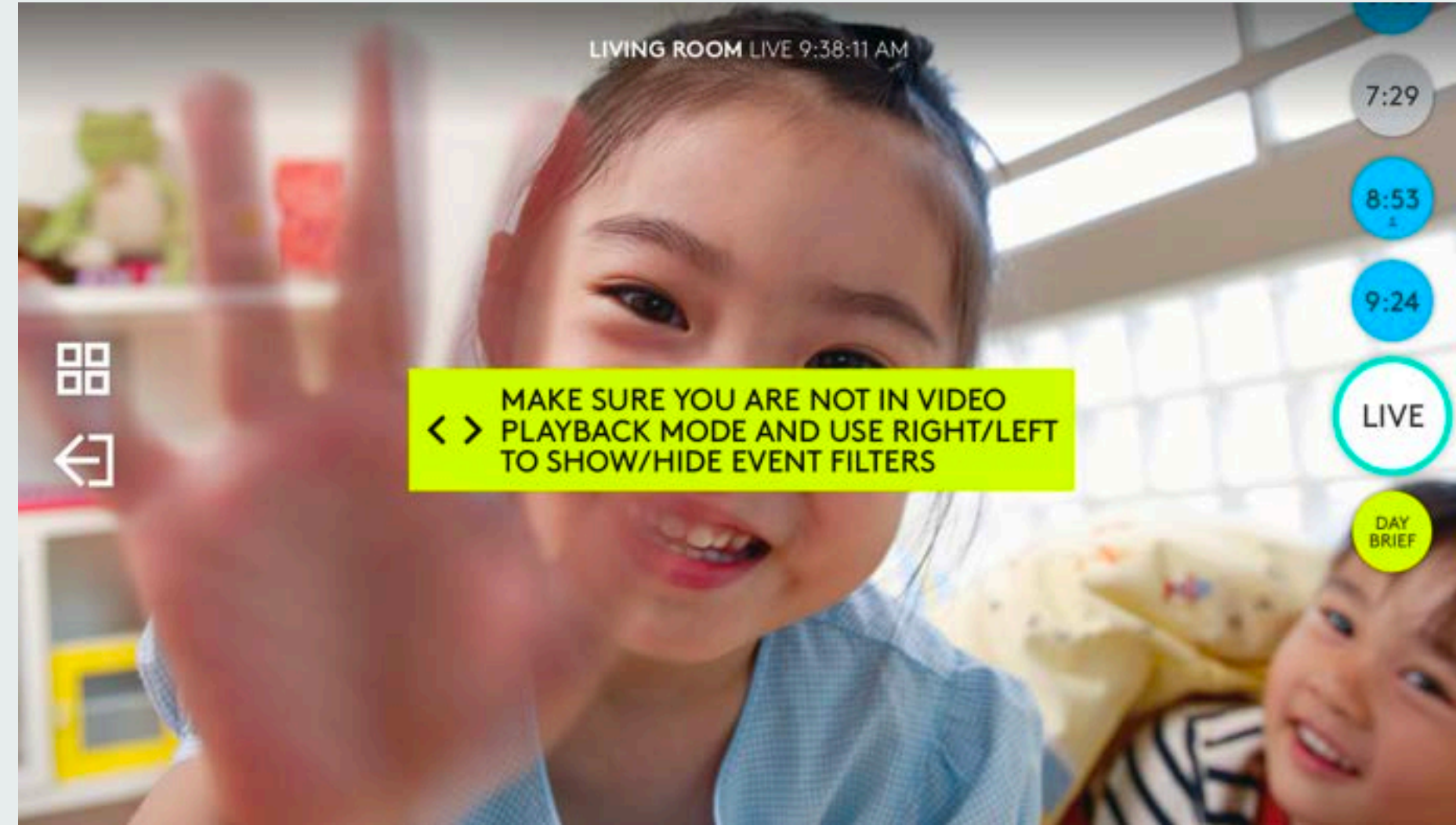
The TV app doesn't not have any Menu settings available. The navigation model is based on a 4 way remote system.

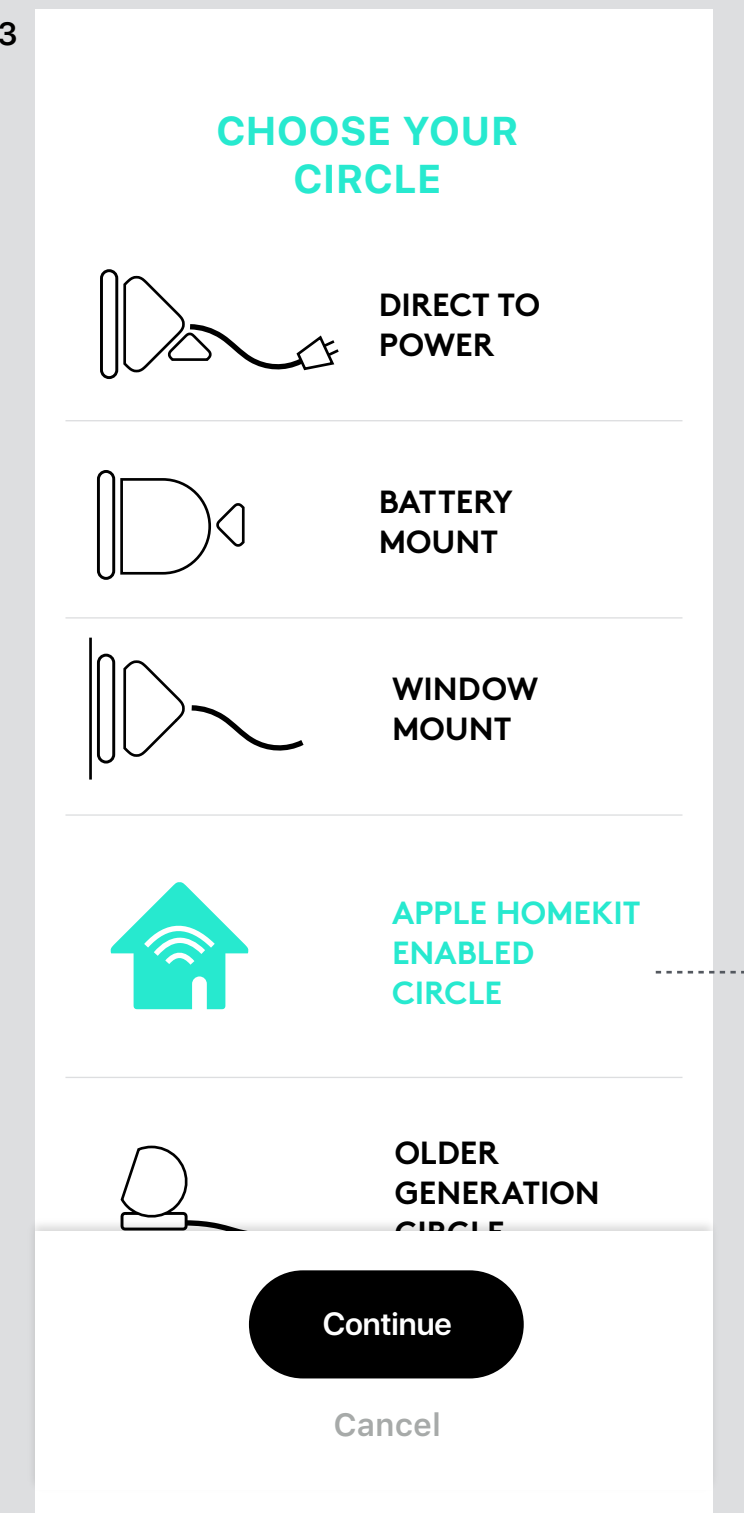
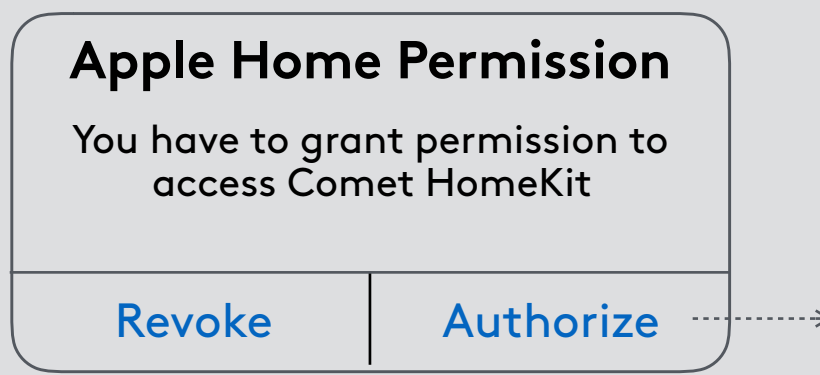
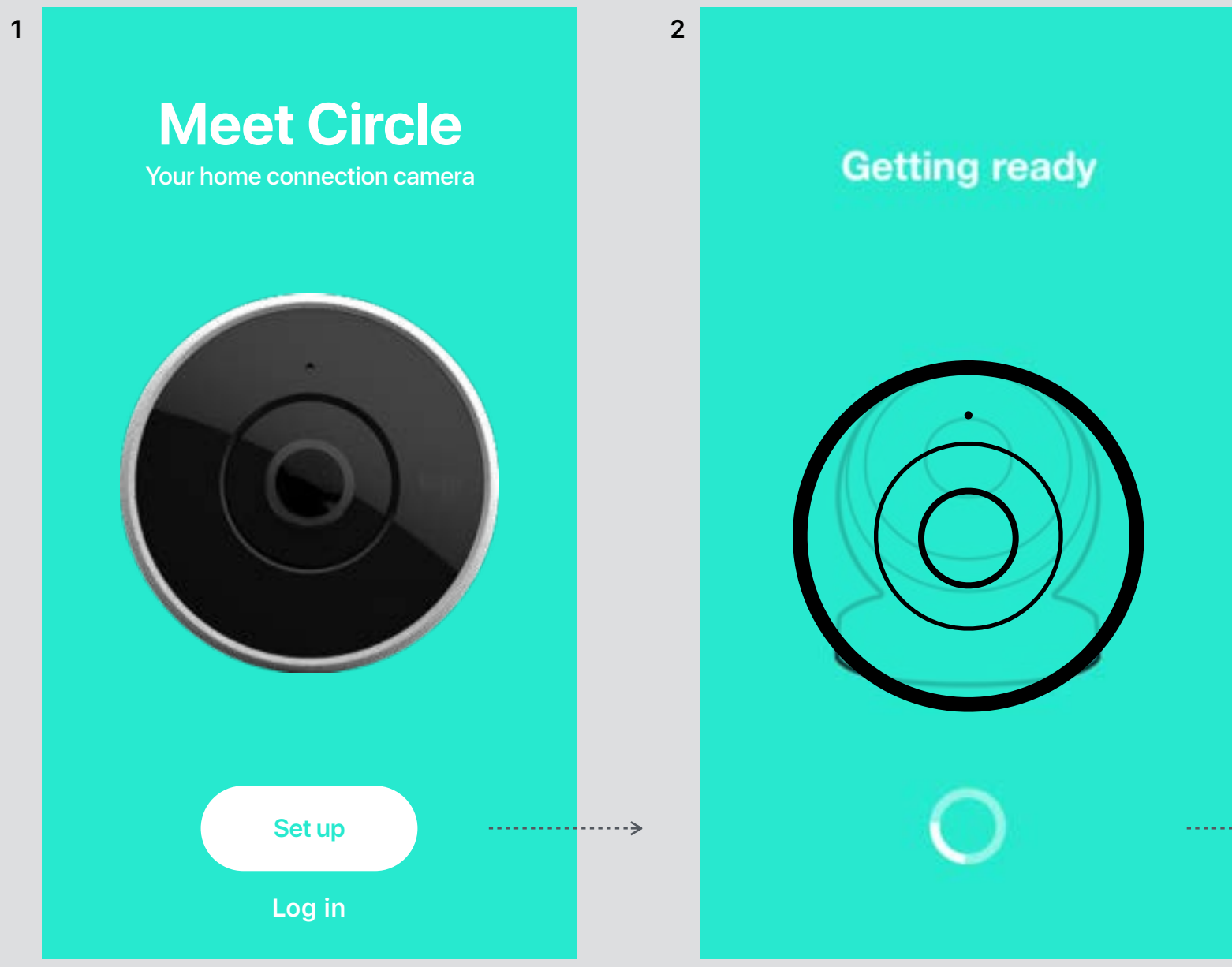
User can directly add HomeKit enabled Circle 2 to apple home app as an accessory and start using or/and add it to Circle 2 app



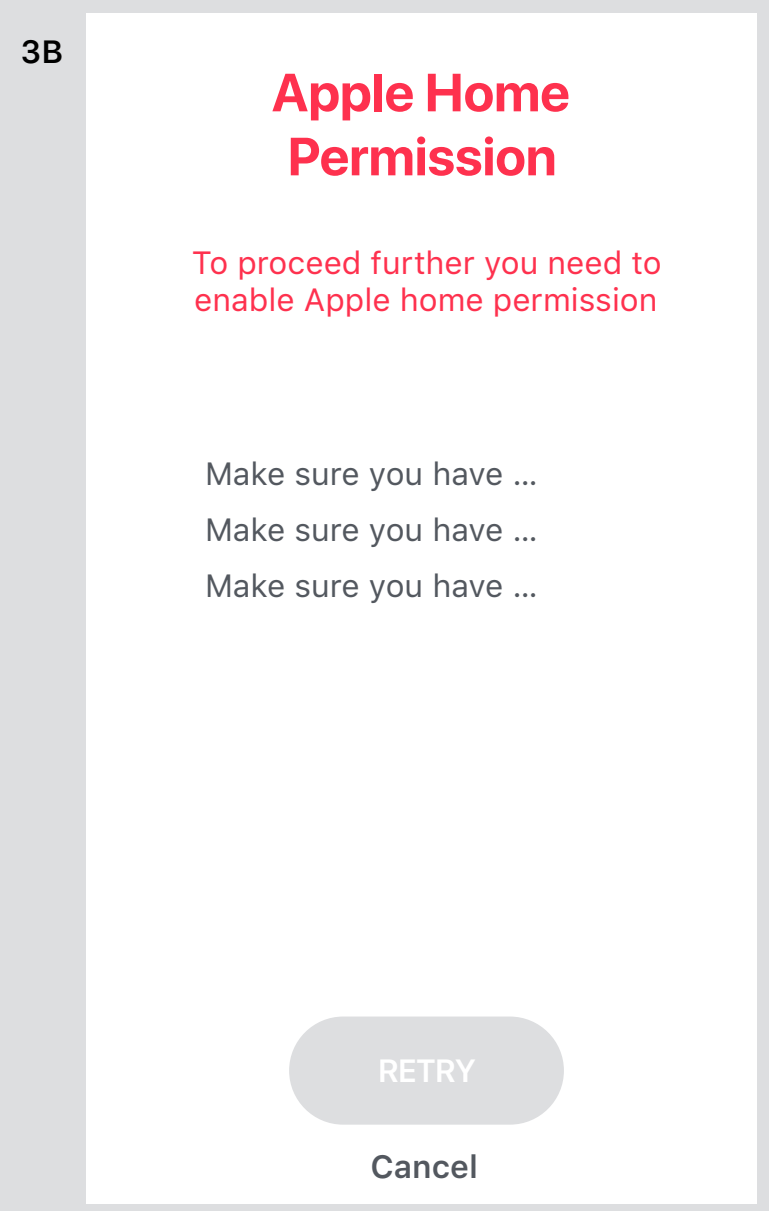
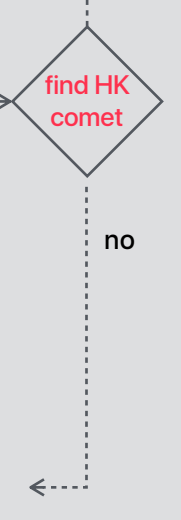
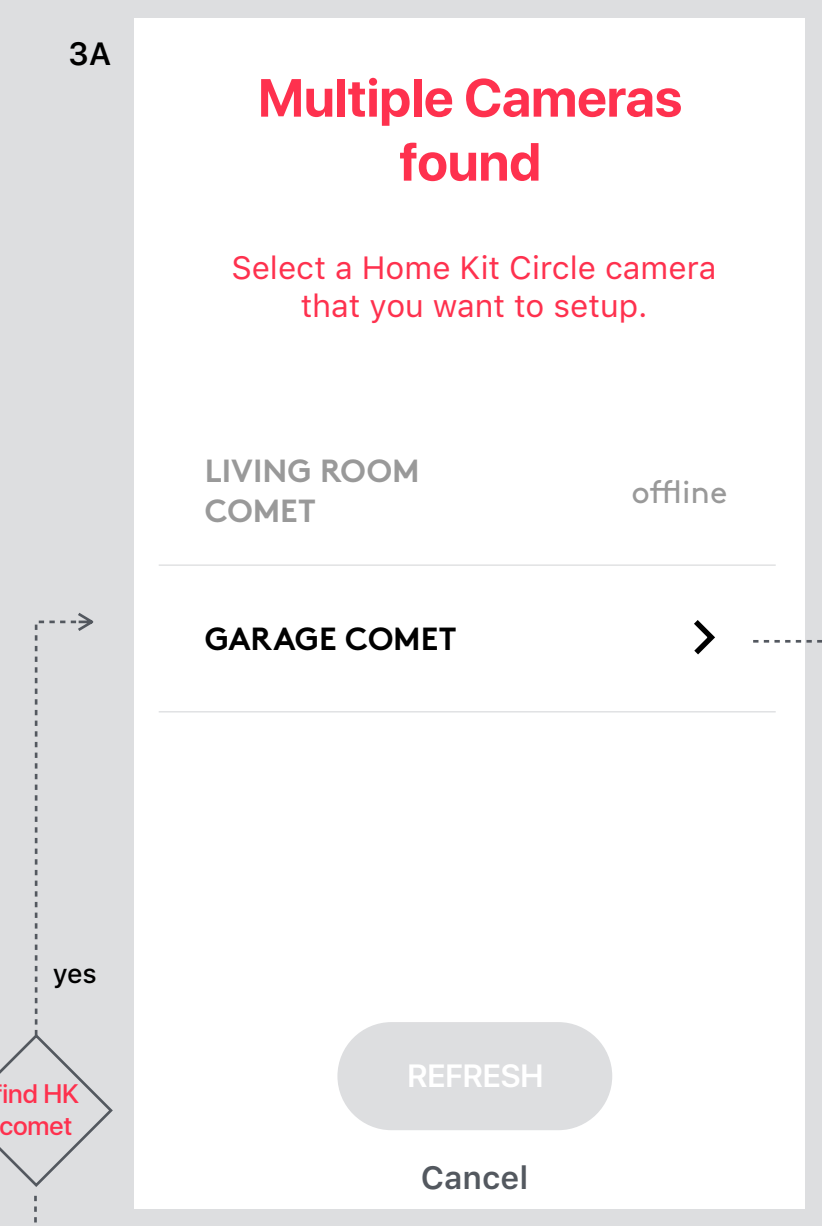
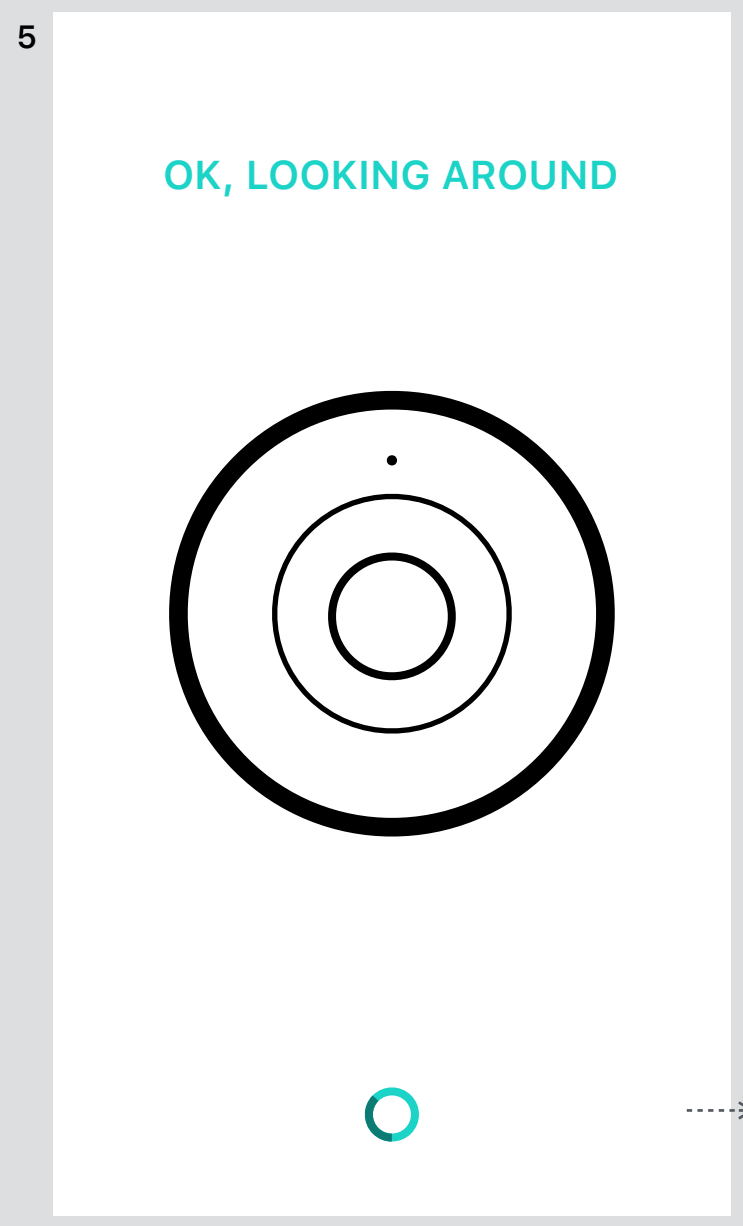
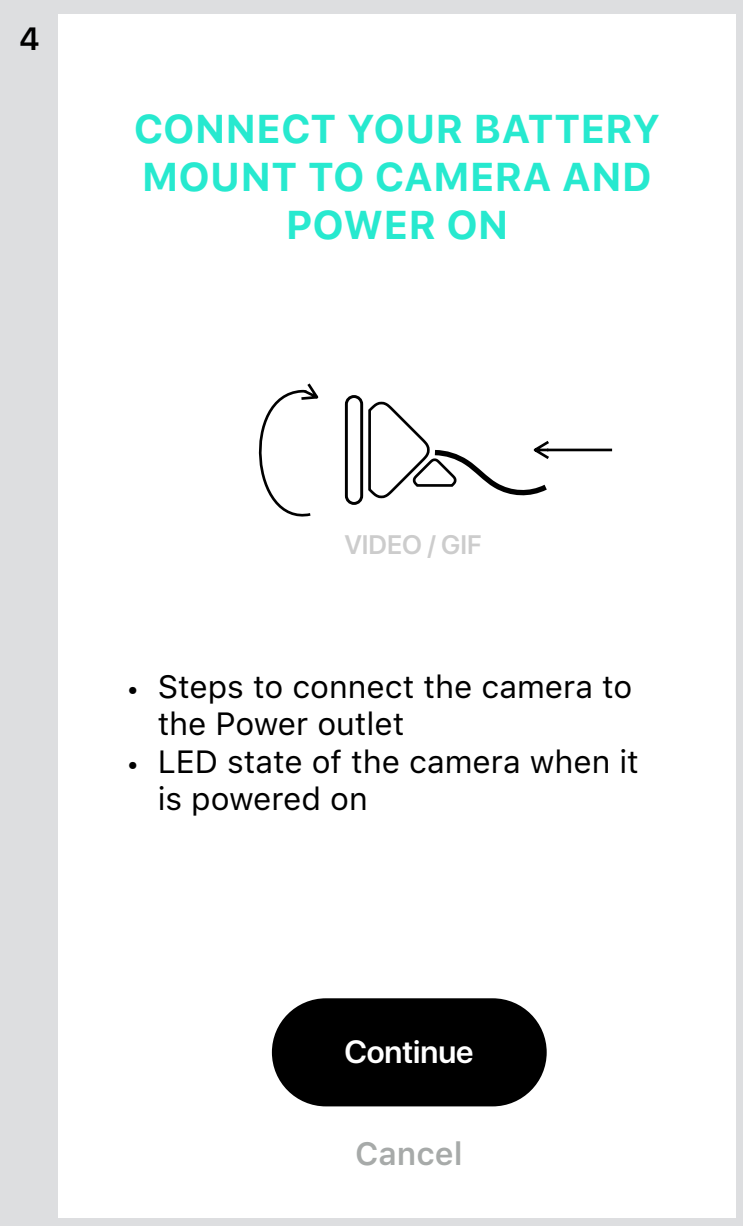
Comet shows up automatically when it is powered up for the first time

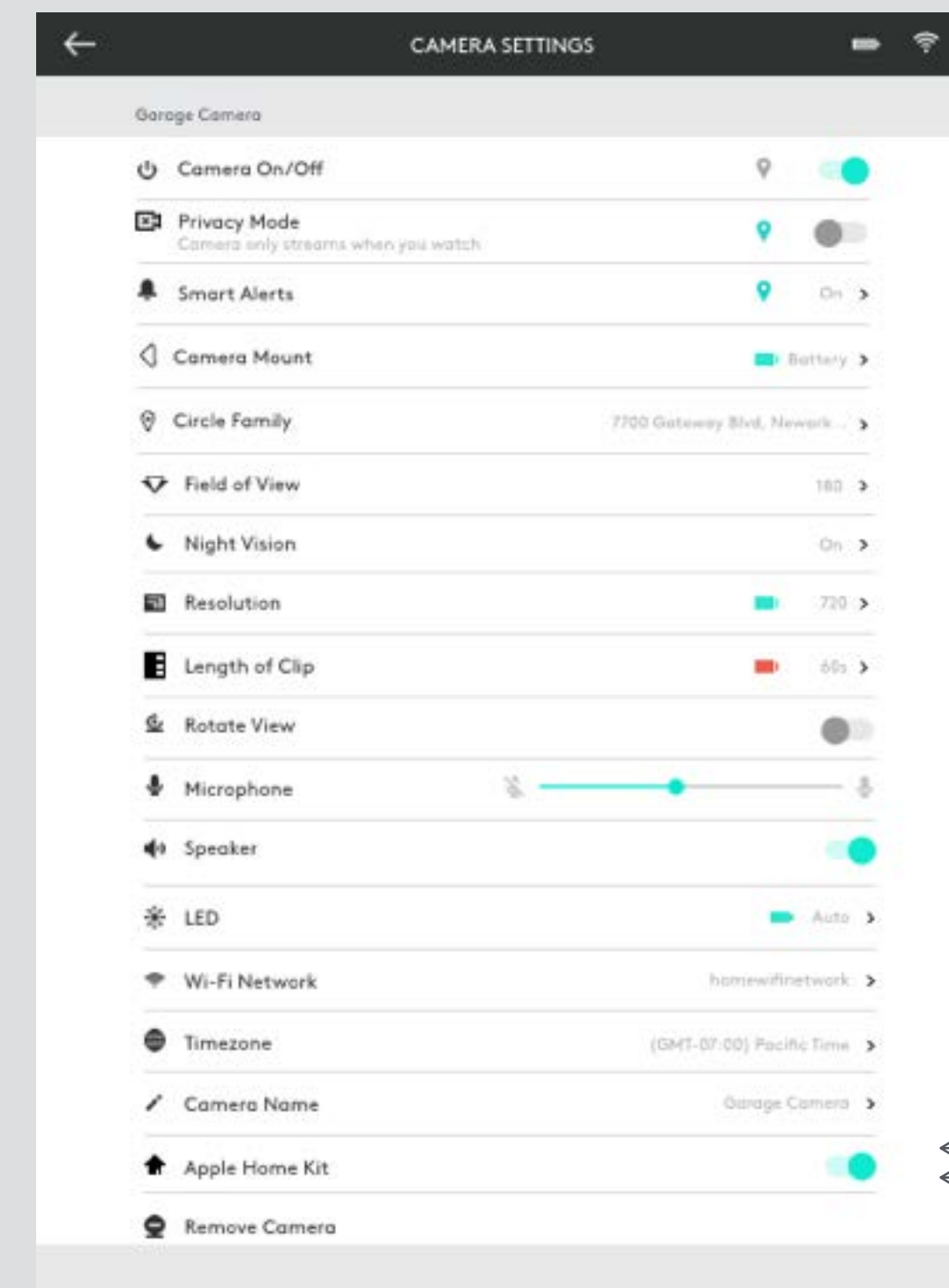


Can we have additional note for users who have accessory setup already using their native app? **In this example - user has to first enable discovery from circle app menu.**

User has to make sure "Apple HomeKit" option is enabled for the camera using the Circle app.

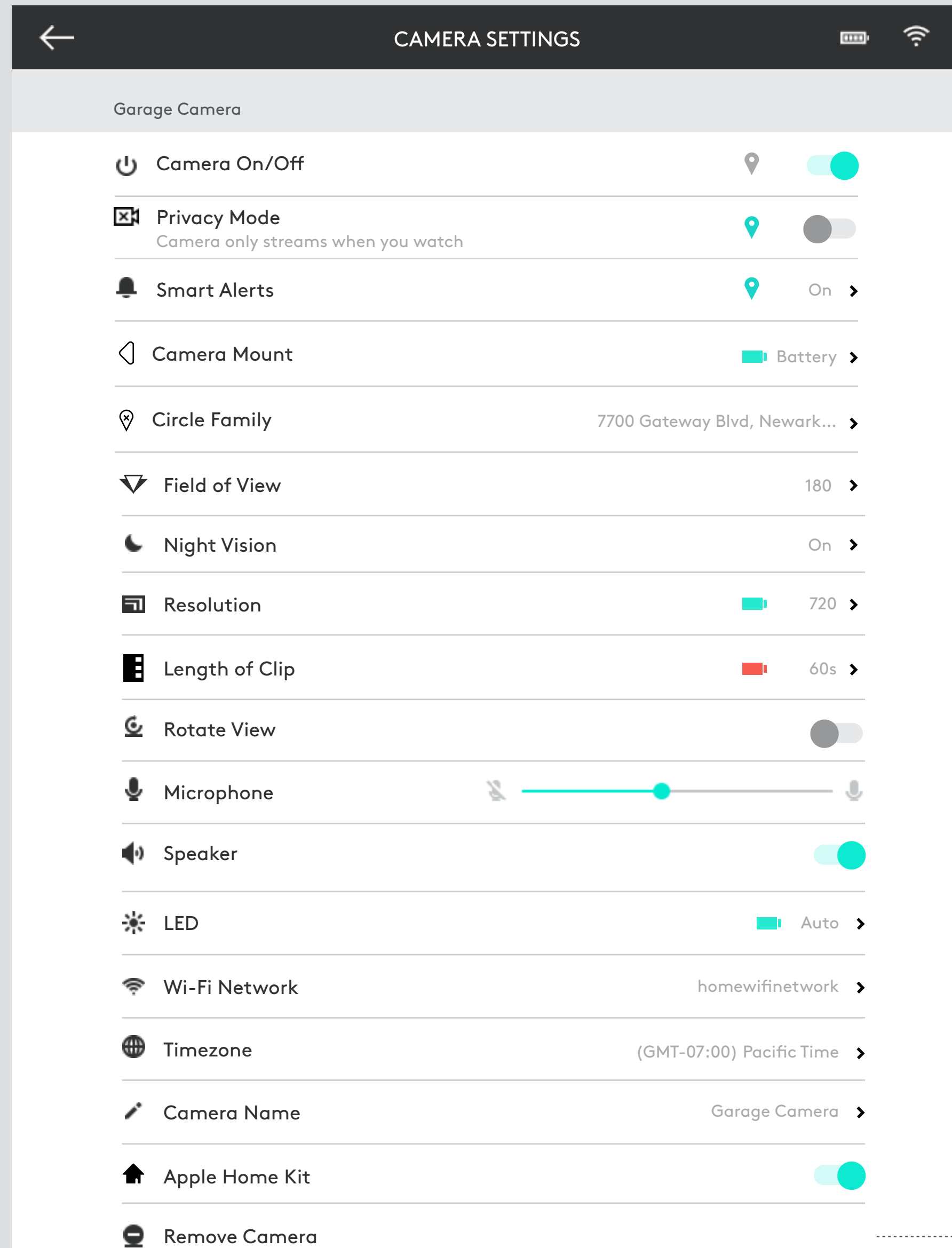


If Comet is found by HomeKit, this button would stay on. Else the button would **toggle back to off** after 30 minutes.

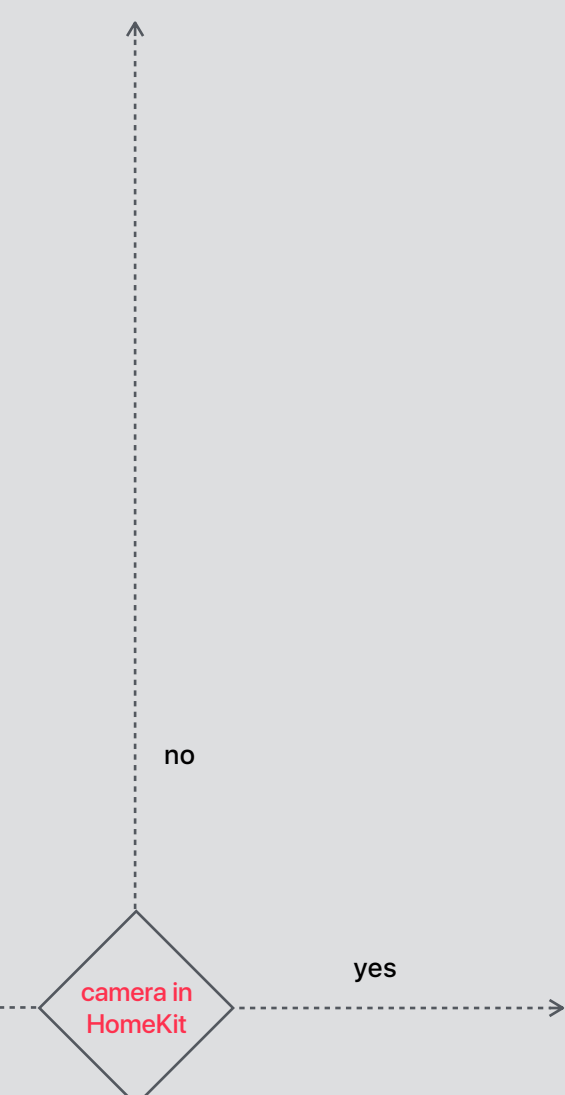
